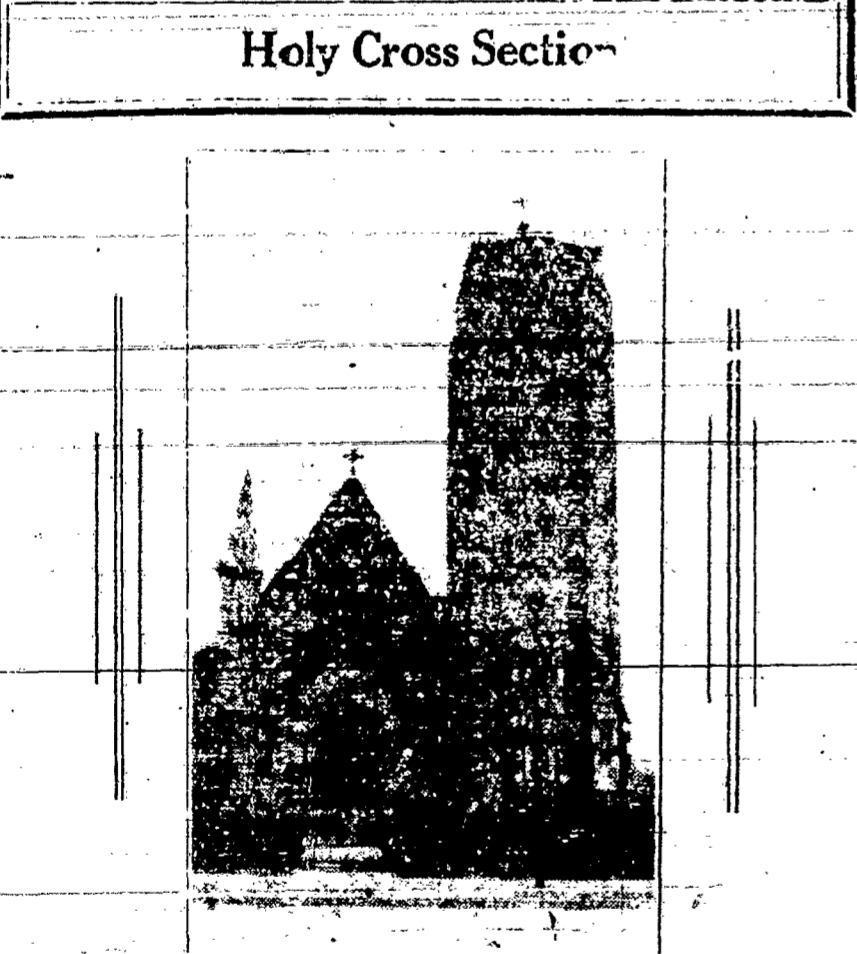

Vatican Radio Station Ready And Is Accepted

Vatican City, Sept. 26.—On Monday afternoon Pope Pius XI accepted and formally took over the Vatican City radio and power plant. With words of high praise for the late Benito Mussolini, inventor of wireless, he blessed its construction. The plant was officially consigned to the care of Father Gianfranceschi, who acted as chaplain at the ceremony of the Noble Arctic expedition of 1928.

Lateran Mosaics Stolen Rome, Sept. 25.—Curators of the Lateran Museum discovered Sunday a number of priceless mosaics and pieces of ancient sculpture were stolen last year. Premier Mussolini and Cardinal Gasparri, then secretary of state of the Holy See, had the Lateran mosaics which harmonized the relations of the Vatican and the Italian state.

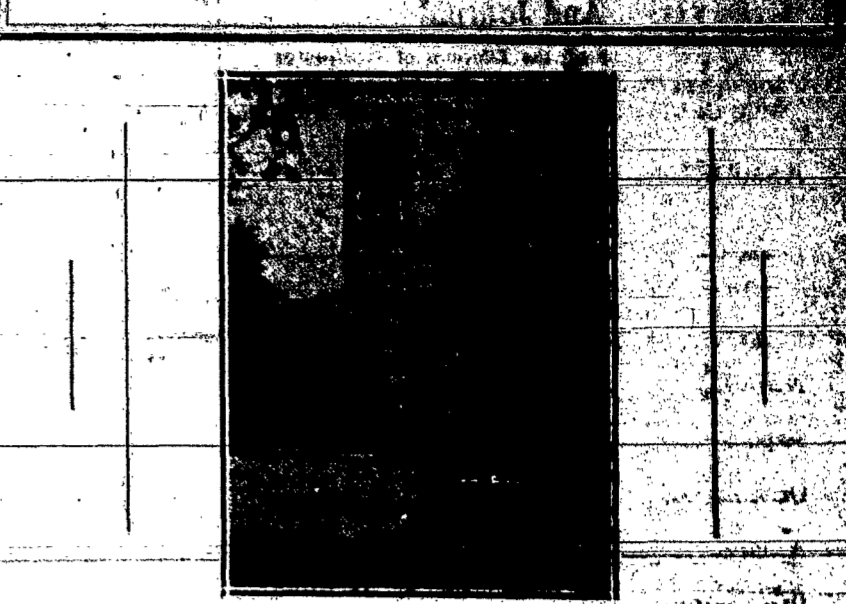
Wall Shingles Exposed More Than Those on Roof
