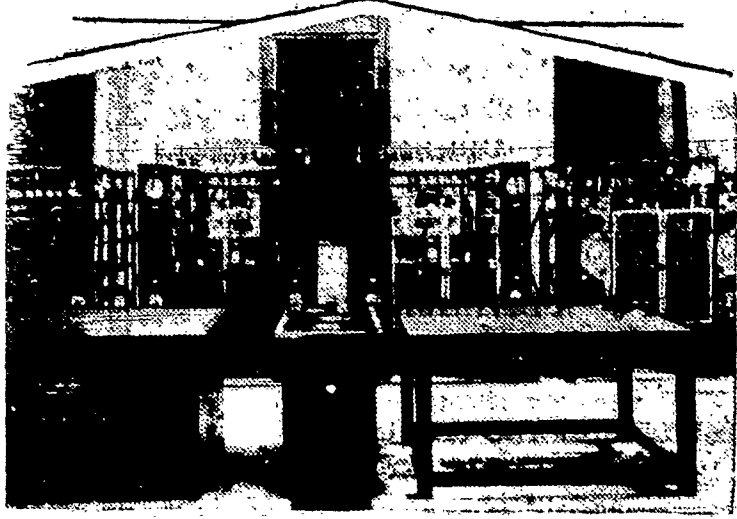

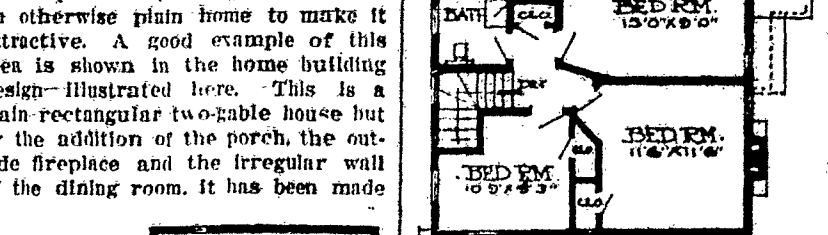
Type of Home Building That Will Appeal to Family of Small Means

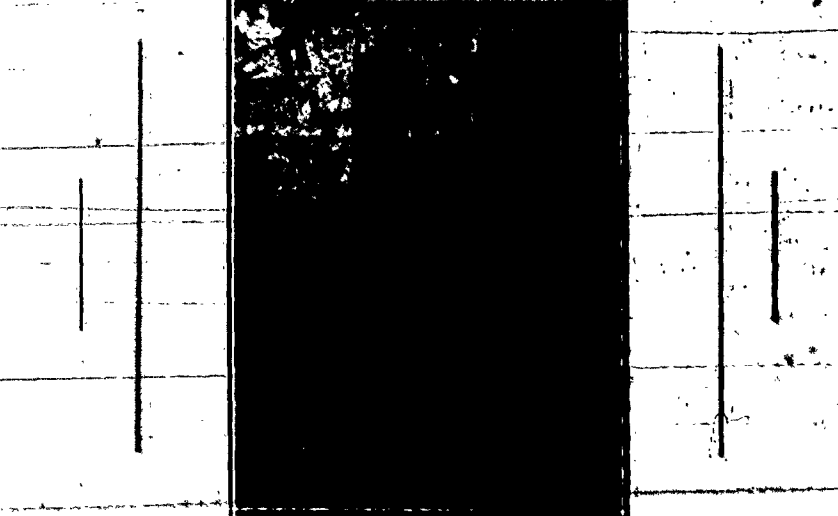

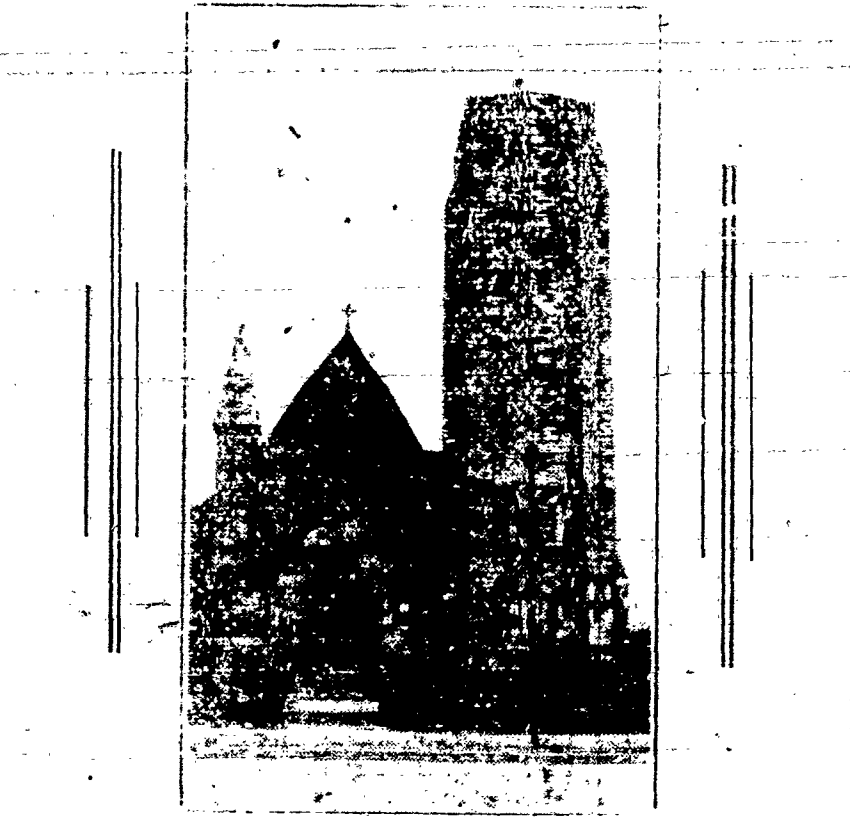
