## Nearly Two Millions On Building Program Of Diocese This Year

New Medical Building for St. Joseph's Hospital, Elmira, to Cost \$400,000-Holy Family School, Rechester, \$250,000 New Church at Phelps and School at Wayland Are on the List.

MORE THAN THREE MILLIONS IN WORK PLANNED BY DIOCESE IN TWO YEARS

A total of \$1,944,752 worth of work is under way at the present time, or will be started in the near future in the Diocese of Rochester, according to an announcement made this week by the Rt. Rev. John Francis O'Hern, D.D., Bishop of Rochester During 1930 a total of \$1,225,850 worth of work was completed in the Diocese, making a total for the two years of \$3,170,602-an outstanding evidence of the fact that Bishop O'Hern has more than lived up to the promises he made early last year when he stated that the Diocese would at once enter upon an extensive program to help the unemployed situation throughout the Discesse. This promise has been kept in full, not only for 1930, but is being continued into 1931 with the same high and helpful motives-for the benefit of all unemployed people, irrespective of race, color or

Highest Church Authority in Western Germany Takes Strong Position Against the Hitlerite Movement.

Cologne, in conjunction with his four Suffragan Bishops of Tries, Munster, Omnabbetieck am d Limburg, was read Sunday, comdenning the National Socialist (Fascist) movement, and warning the people against support-ing it. Cardinal Schulte is the highest Church authority in Western Germany.

Answering injuiries from many Catholies anxions to know what stand to take on the Hitlerite movement, the Cardinal holds that the Church, allouightin perincipal not op-posed to matichalism, has waited long shough for the "Name" to define their sime and allay auxiety on the part of Catholics.

The letter protects against alleged misconceptions of the fundamental Christian truths, paricularly the dogma of the universality, unity and au-therity of the Church, ethical princi-ples and the relationship of Church and State and race and religion which the National Socialist leaders



#### A Historic Occasion

It was the first time in history that Cardinal of the Catholic Church had received such an invitation from a Southern Legislature and the first time in the history of the South that Catholic prelate appeared on the ostrum of a State Semate.

Cardinal Hayen himself called attention to the unusual nature of the occasion and expressed deep appreciatton of the honor paid him by the legislators and the people of Texas. He considered the invitation "preghant with benediction, with impiration to this entire country."
