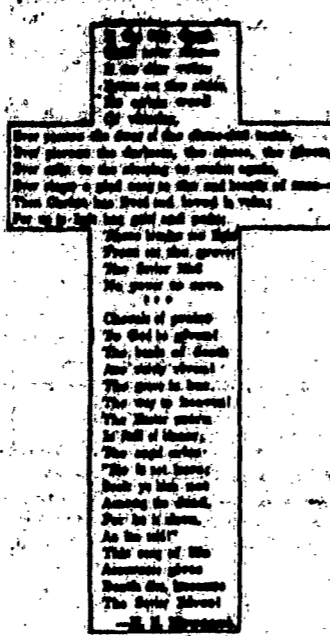

Will Ask Pope to Canonize Elizabeth Ann Seton, Founder of Sisters of Charity in U. S.

Petition Containing One Hundred Thousand Names Will Be Placed Before Him by Federation of Catholic Alumnae.

New York, March 27.—A petition asking for the canonization of Elizabeth Ann Seton, founder and first superior of the Sisters of Charity in the United States, will be placed before Pope Pius XI in July, it was announced here this week.

Mother Seton Born Here Mother Seton was born in New York City, and it is announced she will be the first native-born American Saint.

She Becomes a Catholic On Ash Wednesday, 1805, after her return to New York, she formally entered the Catholic Church, but no sooner had she done so than the attendance at the small school she ran began to dwindle.
