Musical Event On 18th of April By David Kahn

David Kahn, one of the most gifted pianists in America, will give a recital in the Columbus Auditorium, corner Law and Chestnut Streets, on Friday evening, April 17th, under the auspices of the Sisters of Mercy, and for the benefit of Mercy High School on Blossom Road.

David Kahn is a pupil of the celebrated Liszt interpreter, Arthur Friedheim. Before coming under the direction of Friedheim he was engaged in accompaniment work under the noted accompanist and composer, Frank LePage. He did this for a considerable period but abandoned the work to return to solo work.

Kahn was then advised by Henry Johnson of Steinway & Sons, to seek the great master Arthur Friedheim, who was then teaching at the New York School of Music and Arts. Friedheim heard him play, was very warm in his praise and Kahn subsequently became his pupil. Within a short time Friedheim saw the wonderful talent of Kahn and in order to give him more insight into the world of music accepted him as his private pupil. Friedheim predicted success as a concert pianist for his young protegee. By reason of his keen and analytical mind Kahn rapidly assimilated the teaching and theories of his master. Kahn has given recitals in some of the leading cities of the country and Canada. In 1921 he was awarded first prize at the National American Music Festival held at Buffalo where artists from all parts of the country participated.
