Diocesan Novena For Religious Vocations Announced by Bishop

Will Commence May First and End Sunday, May Tenth—Sermons, Instructions and Public and Private Prayers Offered Up for This Intention—Fine Results Obtained Last Year

SPECIAL EXERCISES WILL BE HELD IN ALL SCHOOLS IN THE DIOCESE

The Rt. Rev. John Francis O'Hern, D.D., Bishop of Rochester, has announced a Diocesan-wide Novena for the promotion of Religious vocations, to be held in all Churches of the Diocese, beginning Friday, May 1st, and ending Sunday, May 10th. Sermons, instructions, and public and private prayers will be held in all churches, and there will be special exercises in all parish schools. A similar Novena was held last year, with the result that 31 postulants were received recently into the Order of the Sisters of St. Joseph, something which has not happened in 50 years, Bishop O'Hern says. His letter in this matter to all pastors is as follows:

Vocations Are Needed

"Dear Reverend Father:—
"Again as the month of May comes around, we wish to place before our people, our Religious and our people, the matter of the great need of vocations to our Sisterhoods, especially, and the necessity of discovering vocations among our young women and girls of the Diocese. Accordingly we are calling upon our priests, Sisters, people and children to devote the first nine days of the month of May, namely, from Friday, May 1st to Sunday, May 10th, to an intensive Novena for Religious Vocations, praying Almighty God through His Blessed Mother and St. Joseph to send more workers into the vineyard of the Lord, by obtaining postulants and novices for our various Sisterhoods.
"The novena, as in the case of last year, will, of course, be a diocesan-wide one in which sermons, instructions, public and private prayers will be offered up for this special intention by all our dioceses. On Sunday, May 3rd, the instruction and sermon should be on the subject of 'Vocations,' and the public prayers to be recited should be said either in the morning after the last weekday Mass or in the evening in connection with the public May Devotions. Those

prayers may consist of the Rosary and Litany of Our Blessed Lady together with any approved special prayers for vocations which the pastor or principal of the school may select. Moreover, during the first week of May, May Devotions should be held in every church every morning or evening, to be followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

Exercises in Schools

"While these prayers are being said in public in the churches of the Diocese, special exercises should be held in all our parochial schools through which the Sisters and children of the schools will join their prayers with those of the people of the parishes for the purpose of obtaining more vocations to the Sisterhoods. Thanks be to God! vocations to the Priesthood are now abundant as we have more than two hundred boys registered in St. Andrew's Seminary who are studying and preparing for higher studies at St. Bernard's Seminary. We all know how Almighty God will listen to the prayers of innocent children, and therefore we depend very much upon the prayers of our thousands of little ones in our schools and institutions

The Catholic Theater Movement Publishes Its Spring Bulletin With Comments on New Plays

Five Productions Considered Worthy of Place on "White List"—Thirty-eight Plays in All Are Covered—Some Reek with Filth

New York, May 1. — The Spring Bulletin of the Catholic Theater Movement of New York City is out. The Bulletin publishes comments on 38 plays in all. Five of these are considered worthy of a place on the "White List"—a list that can be recommended unreservedly to theatergoers as plays that are clean, wholesome and strong. A number of the others fairly reek with filth.

Plays on the "White List" are: "The Admirable Crichton," by Sir James Matthew Barrie—"The whole thing is fun; a beautiful and simple and canny play."
"Colonel Satan," by Booth Tarkington—"A play of wiles and counter wiles of romantic conspiracy, riddles, pistols and dropped handkerchiefs; of disguises, duels and secret police."

"The House Beautiful," by Channing Pollock—"Conspicuous for its purity and containing much sound dramatic stuff."
"Peter Ibbetson," a dramatization of George du Maurier's novel by Constance Collier and John G. Raphael—"A revival of a play that will delight many."

"Philip Goes Forth," by George Kelly—"It has a real message, and it is clever throughout. It is the sort of play decent playgoers enjoy and like to take their young folks to."

The other kind of stuff is in the Bulletin under the heading: "General List." Here are a few samples: "Getting Married," by George Bernard Shaw—"He is irreverent, flippant, a deliberate mocker of sacred things." "But cleverness should blind us to its utter viciousness."
"The Great Man," by Paul Harvey Fox—"An inert tale of comic lust and piracy." "A flimsy huddle of nursery romance and sex-show, giving no definite pleasure to either the innocent or the vicious."

"Greater Love," by Bruce Spaulding and Anthony Baird—"An artless but glib drama which grows worse from scene to scene, until it ends in minor poetry."
"Green Grow the Lilacs," by Lynn Riggs—"The splattering of blasphemies, on the usual grounds of realism, is inexcusable," but "Mr. Riggs' play is the only logical candidate up to now for this season's Pulitzer prize."

Columbia Class Votes Many Ways On Many Subjects

Seniors Don't Like Hoover; Prohibition or the College Chapel—"Green Pastures" Their Favorite Play

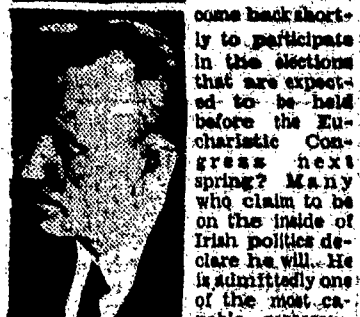
New York, May 1.—The Senior Class of Columbia College told the world a few things in its annual poll the other day. The class voted on 55 different subjects. Here are some of the results:

The Class, though having a Republican plurality, doesn't like Hoover, and is opposed to his re-nomination, and is also opposed to Prohibition. Of the Class, 123 go to church regularly, 69 are agnostics and 18 are atheists. Ninety-eight said they never go to college chapel for services. Sinclair Lewis is the favorite author of the Class; "All Quiet on the Western Front," the best book and motion picture of the year; "Green Pastures," the best play; Jane Cowl and Walter Hampden, the best actors; Greta Garbo and Ronald Colman, the best movie stars; the Ford car, the best auto; football, the best sport.

Only 27 members of the Class voted dry. Exactly 202 seniors called for a change in the prohibition laws, 14 declaring for modification and 188 for repeal of the Eighteenth Amendment.

Irish Minister Is Back in Dublin For the Elections

DUBLIN.—Will Michael MacWhite, minister from the Irish Free State, came back shortly to participate in the elections that are expected to be held before the Easter Congress next spring. Many who claim to be on the inside of Irish politics declare he will. He is said to be one of the most capable representatives in the Free State's service and it is rumored that one of the highest posts in the land can be his if he will agree to run for the office.

Bishops Named For Toledo, O., And Denver, Col.

Vatican City, May 1.—The Rev. Karl J. Alter, L.L.D., president of the National Catholic School for Social Service at Washington, D. C., was appointed Bishop of Toledo, O., by Pope Pius on Wednesday last week. Rector Urban J. Vehr, J.C.L., rector of St. Mary's Theological Seminary of the West at Cincinnati, was named Bishop of Denver, Col.

Bishop Alter will succeed the Rt. Rev. Samuel A. Stritch, who was recently promoted to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. He is 46 years of age, and has been a priest for 23 years. Bishop Vehr is 40 years of age. He was Archdiocesan Superintendent of Catholic schools in the Cincinnati Archdiocese for several years and was active in the work of laymen's organizations. He recently resigned because of ill health.

Cardinal Says Child in School Is in Sanctuary

Archbishop of New York Dedicates New \$250,000 School, But Now to Help Relieve Unemployment

New York, May 1. — "We love our school, and a school like this will champion the best among the public schools. Placing a child in a Catholic school is like bringing him into the sanctuary, and placing him before the altar of God."

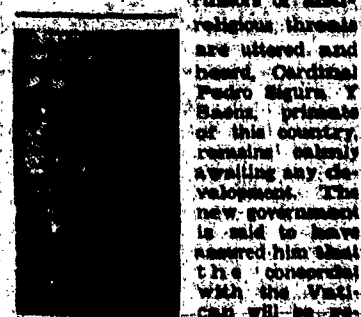
The above statement was made by Cardinal Hayes, of New York, while he was dedicating the new \$250,000 building of St. Anthony's Parochial School, St. Lawrence Avenue and Madison Street, Bronx.

After blessing the school, the Cardinal entered it to look at the building. The Cardinal then spoke and blessed the school. He said: "The Catholic Church, in this time of widespread economic depression, was endeavoring to do what it could to help the unemployed. The opening of this monumental building is an event of no small importance. It is the efforts of city and state in the field of education, but we are not satisfied with their efforts, especially because we think every child should have religious training. We are going to do this in this school, because we think it is better for men and women to help them to save their souls, souls for God."

The new building, which will be used as a school, a community center, and a place for religious instruction, will provide meeting rooms, auditorium and gymnasium for the parish.

Many Mourners At the Funeral Of Dr. J. G. Coyle

Knights of Columbus From All Parts of State Attended Services in New York—Friends to Establish a Memorial

New York, May 1.—Hundreds of friends from all parts of the State, most of them Knights of Columbus, attended the funeral here on Saturday of Dr. John G. Coyle, past State Deputy of the K. of C., and one of the outstanding Catholic men in America. The funeral Mass was celebrated in the Church of the Holy Name, West 69th Street and Amsterdam Avenue. The church was filled to capacity, and several hundred were unable to gain admission to the Church. It was one of the finest tributes, many priests said, ever paid to a Catholic layman in New York City. The Rt. Rev. John J. Dunn, D.D., Auxiliary Bishop of New York, presided in the sanctuary, and more than 50 priests were present. Interment was made in the Gates of Heaven Cemetery.

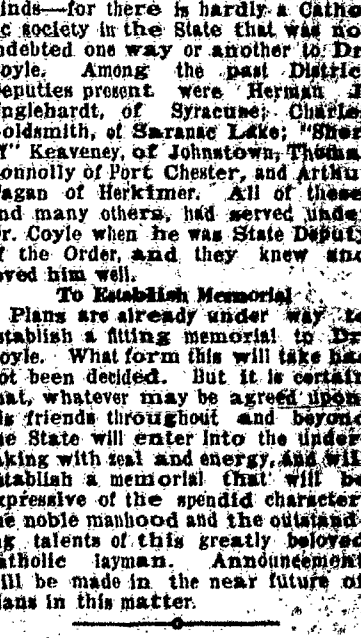
Many K. of C. officials were present, including Supreme Knight Martin H. Carmody; Supreme Secretary William J. McGinley; most of the Supreme Directors of the Order; State Deputy Walter Lynch, of New York City; Past State Deputy Michael J. Larkin, of Bronx, N. Y.; Past State Deputy James Flanagan, of New York; Past State Deputy Daniel A. Tobin, of Brooklyn; many District Deputies and Grand Knights from many places, besides hundreds of members.

There were numerous delegations present from Catholic societies of all kinds—for there is hardly a Catholic society in the State that was not indebted one way or another to Dr. Coyle. Among the past District Deputies present were Herman J. Bielehard, of Syracuse; Charles Goldsmith, of Saratoga Lake; "Shen" Keaveney, of Johnstown; Thomas Connolly, of Port Chester, and Arthur Fagan, of Herkimer. All of these, and many others, had served under Dr. Coyle when he was State Deputy of the Order, and they knew and loved him well.

To Establish Memorial

Plans are already under way to establish a fitting memorial to Dr. Coyle. What form this will take has not been decided. But it is certain that whatever may be agreed upon, his friends throughout the State will enter into the undertaking with zeal and energy, and will establish a memorial that will be expressive of the splendid character, the noble manhood and the outstanding talents of this greatly beloved Catholic layman. Announcement will be made in the near future of plans in this matter.
