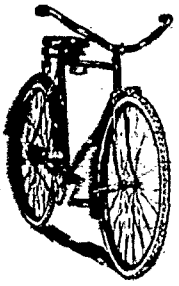

**Donegal Church Is Consecrated On Holy Island**  
Donegal, Ireland, May 29.—Accompanied by a dozen Irish Bishops and conveying the apostolic blessing of Pope Pius XI, Cardinal MacRory recently consecrated the new church on Holy Island.

The church, reckoned as the most modern in the country, is on a site which tradition has held to be the most sacred spot in the territory of Celtic peoples. Holy Island is in Lake Derg, County of Donegal.

Pilgrims from all parts of Ireland attended the ceremonies. The government was represented by President William T. Cosgrave, Eamon de Valera and the chairman of the Free State Senate also were present.

At 8:30 the Academic Procession will make its way to Sacred Heart Church, for the solemn Pontifical Mass, which will be said by the Right Rev. John F. Noll, D.D., LL.D., Bishop of Fort Wayne, Indiana. The Most Rev. Chob. will also attend these services. The SEME FLAG will be blessed, and about noon the flag raising exercises will be held on the main quadrangle of the campus. At 1:30 that afternoon degrees will be conferred and Mr. McDonald will give his address.

At 5:30 the Academic Procession will make its way to Sacred Heart Church, for the solemn Pontifical Mass, which will be said by the Right Rev. John F.
