Notre Dame Makes Changes In 1932 Football Schedule

Notre Dame, June 19. — Jesse C. Harper, director of athletics at Notre Dame University, has made some changes in the football schedule. Indiana and Pennsylvania will be dropped from Notre Dame's 1932 football schedule and will be replaced by Kansas and Haskell Institute. The seven other teams on the 1931 schedule drawn up by Knute Rockne will be retained, Harper said.

The Kansas game will be at Lawrence, and the Kansasans will play here in 1932. It was also announced that Pittsburg will be on the Irish schedule in 1932 at Pittsburg, and in 1934 at Notre Dame stadium.

attain the marvelous unity of the divine plan.

This is the perfect order which the Church preaches with intense earnestness, and which right reason demands; which places God as the first and supreme end of all created goods as mere instruments under God to be used only in so far as they help toward the attainment of our supreme end.

Faith and Reason

Nor is it to be imagined that remunerative occupations are thereby belittled or deemed less consonant with human dignity. On the contrary, we are taught to recognize and reverence in them the manifest will of God the Creator, who placed man upon earth to work it and use it in various ways in order to supply his needs. Those who are engaged in production are not forbidden to increase their fortunes in a lawful and just manner; indeed it is just that he who renders service to society and develops its wealth should himself have his proportionate share of the increased public riches, provided always that he respects the laws of God and the rights of his neighbor and uses his property in accord with faith and right reason.
