All Priests Will Continue Their Work Until Removed or Arrested by the Authorities-Law Limits One Priest to 100,000 People.

SIX PERSONS KILLED AT HIS FUNERAL

Mexico City, June 26.—The great Mexican state of Vera Cruz as enacted a law limiting the number of Catholic priests to one or every 100,000 inhabitants. Archbishop Ruiz y Flores, Aposolic Delegate to Mexico, has appealed to President Oritz Rubio for ederal intervention, but it is not expected that the President will able to accomplish much in the matter. The Archbishop has nnounced that the Church will not obey the law, but that all-riests will continue at their posts, officiating as usual, until prested or removed by authorities. There is great excitement the State over the new law, and many petitions against it are ing circulated. If any priests are forcibly removed, the Church ill apply for an injunction against the State on the ground that he law is unconstitutional.


