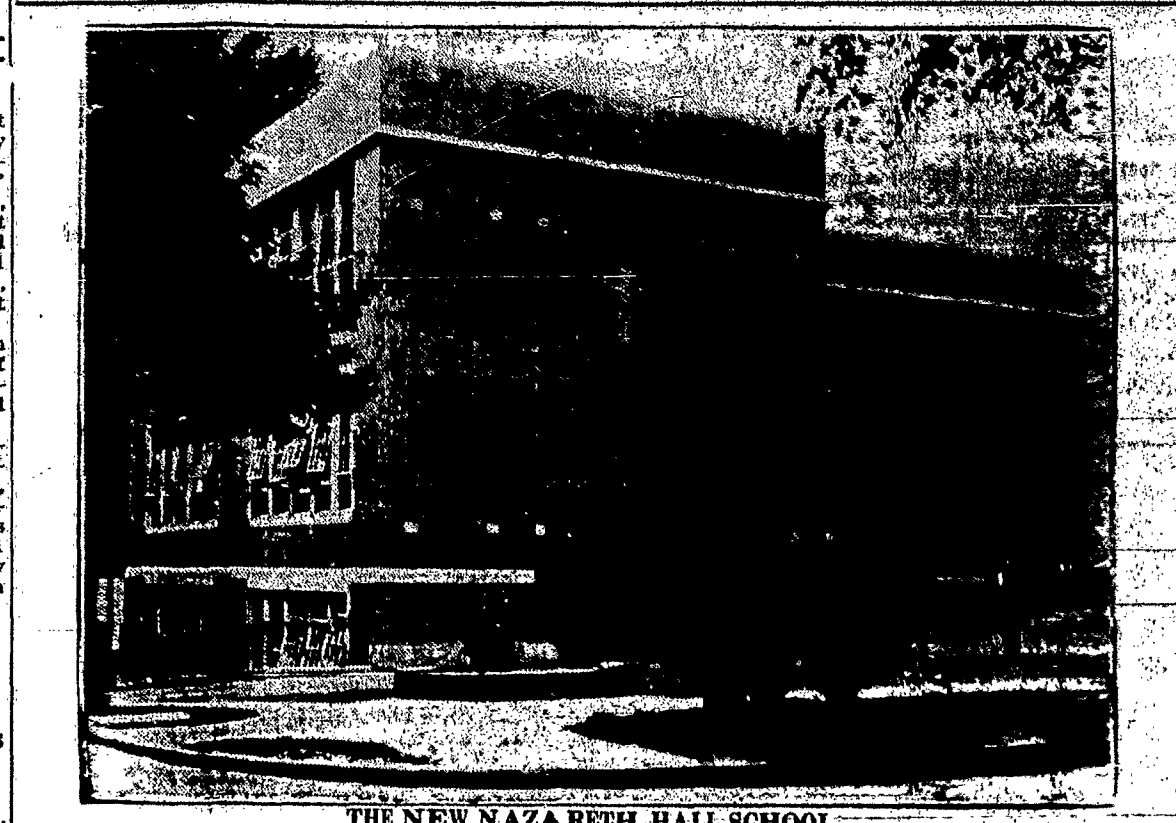


Engagements
