## It Takes Six Years for Cardinal Hayes To Make the Rounds of New York Diocese

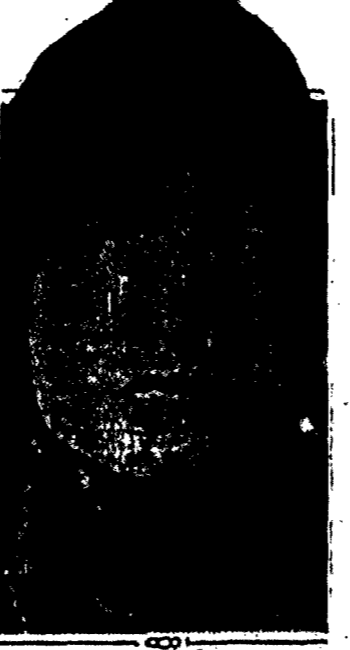
New York, Oct. 9.—It requires six years for Cardinal Hayes to visit all parts of the New York Diocese, he told a congregation of people at the Church of the Sacred Heart in the Bronx last Sunday. The church, enlarged to twice its original size, was re-dedicated by the Cardinal, and now ranks among the first parishes of the New York archdiocese.

The Cardinal expressed regret that his heavy burden of duties made it impossible for him to mingle more with those in the city who looked to him for spiritual guidance. I regret that the size of the archdiocese and my multiplicity of duties do not enable me to get around among my people as I would like to. It takes me six years to make the rounds of my diocese," he said.

The Cardinal praised the parishioners for their work in expanding the church in their efforts to "come nearer to Him."

"I am overjoyed," he told them "to find people like you crowding in on Christ. It is a great privilege to be able to build a church. Once the privilege to build churches belonged only to the great. That is all gone, and now people of all faiths are the builders of the age."

## Belief Is Held That Spain Will Not Hurt Church

Minister of Economy Says Verbal Agreement Has Been Reached With the Vatican.

Madrid, Oct. 9.—The general basis of a verbal understanding between the Spanish government and the Vatican as a result of the conferences among President Alcala Zamora, Foreign Minister Larroux and the Papal Nuncio was revealed in a statement made last week by the Minister of Economy, Nicolas D'Olivier in the newspaper La Voz.

Senator D'Olivier believes that in the separation of Church and State the neutrality of the latter will be approved by the national constitutional assembly, as well as the equality of men and women before the law. He is of the opinion that there will be no prohibition of religious public processions and other manifestations outside the churches, such as the world-famous Holy Week procession in Seville.

This coincides with what is generally understood to be the outcome of the official discussions in which the Nuncio is said on good authority to have been moderate in his demands, recognizing that certain changes were in evidence.

It is believed in Church circles that President Alcala Zamora's telephonic conversations with Senator Larroux, who was presiding over the League of Nations Council sessions in Geneva, were to arrange for the Foreign Minister's return to Madrid to support a settlement on this basis, and for this reason further discussions of the relations between Church and State have been postponed.

Plans for most of the government proposals have prevailed in the Cortes and Senator D'Olivier's statement pre-supporters that the delegates will follow the same lead this week. Both the government and the Vatican maintain official silence, denying any agreement has yet been reached.
