Bridgeport, Conn., Oct. 30.—Mrs. Finley J. Shepard, daughter of Jay Gould, has sounded a warning that "the world is definitely and dangerously drifting toward atheism."

In an address at the annual reunion of the Hawley family Friday night, she urged the need for religion.

"Unless the Christian religion is taught more forcibly in our schools and colleges, I can see little hope for members of the future generation," she said. "We need religion to direct the body of mankind which is rapidly sinking into the quagmire of atheistic belief."


