"Father, it's like a dream. The trip across the continent was uneventful. I reached San Francisco in due time. I met my little family. They were glad to see me, and I was glad to see them. I said nothing to my wife about what had happened. I had quite a battle yet to fight. There were a few major difficulties which I had to settle before I could commence my instructions. But I fought them out with myself.

"The gift, the case on Calvary, as it is likewise the object offered, since as in this mystical and that sanguinary sacrifice, Jesus Christ, His body and blood, His holy Humanity united hypostatistically with the Eternal Word, obtains an infinite value. This value is estimated from the Person who offers it, from the divine dignity and grandeur of the person, sacrificially, would impart infinite value.

"The Holy Mass, Father, which I attended in the Cathedral, and which I have since attended faithfully every Sunday and Holyday, has a value absolutely infinite. But as regards the effects—now don't smile because I have caught the theological distinction of a Catholic—the Mass is a sacrifice. Sacrifice originates from Christ, not in so far as He offered for Himself on the Altar, but in so far as He once offered Himself on the Cross. Satisfaction and merit are no longer acquired, but merely applied to the soul from the treasure of merit.

Architecture of New Cork Church Highly Praised

Cork, Dec. 31.—A new church at Turner's Cross, Cork, which has just been opened and blessed by the Rt. Rev. Daniel Cohalan, Bishop of Cork, is highly praised for its architecture. It is elliptical rather than rectangular in outline. An uninterrupted view of the altar is obtainable from every part of the building. The church was designed by Barry Byrne of Chicago.

The exterior of the church is of most striking appearance. An impressive carving in stone of Christ the King, to whom it is dedicated, stands on the entrance lower, which is 100 feet high. The walls are finished in white cement, contrasting with the buff tiles of the roof.

The interior is dominated by the altar and its reredos, which, with two smaller altars and the sanctuary, are of pre-cast terrazo, with yellow and gold mosaic. A canopy of highly-polished brass covers the high altar. There are no interior-supporting pillars.

Sister M. Theresia

Word has been received in this city of the recent death in Harrison, N. Y., of Sister M. Theresia, one of the oldest members of the Sisters of Charity in the world. Sister M. Theresia was an aunt of Frank P. Hayes of Woodburn Avenue, Rochester. She was born near Limerick, Ireland, 24 years ago, came to America with her parents when a child, and remained in the place of her birth until she was 15 years of age, when she sailed for New York. She was still standing and in excellent health by relatives who still occupy the farm that was cleared and tilled by the father of Sister M. Theresia 100 years ago.

For 40 years Sister M. Theresia was a member of the order of the Sisters of Charity. She taught school in Brooklyn for some years, and in New York, but for the past 47 years was located at St. Vincent's Retreat, Harrison, N. Y., where she died. Her funeral was held in the beautiful chapel at the Retreat. It was a touching scene, with the aid of the most competent and experienced nurses, and the other side with nurses in pure white uniforms.
