Evening gowns frequently introduce a wide girle of crystal or colored bead embellished material around the waist. Often a contrasting color makes this wrapped girle more emphatic.

### Newest Evening Wraps Are Furred at Hemline

The newest evening wraps are furred at the bottom instead of the top. Half-length jackets worn with summer evening frocks are designed with simple unornamented necklines and flaring pelmets banded with fur. Even the flowered chiffon jackets use the fur treatment in this way.

### Brown in Accessories New Much in Evidence

The debutante will do well to include at least one set of brown street accessories in her autumn and winter wardrobe, for brown hats, shoes, bags and gloves are much in evidence with the colorful new wooleens—especially with green, which is seen everywhere. Included in these might be one of the new long narrow handbags in brown calf, oxfords of brown suede and calf, handstitched gloves of brown suede, mesh hose in medium or dark brown, a scarf of wool plaid in brown combined with the costume color, sports—handkerchief or beige and brown linen, and a necklace of roundels of wood combined with beads of gold or aluminum. A hat of brown felt may repeat the costume color in its feather ornament or ribbon cockade. Such a set of accessories may well be worn with several winter costumes.

### STYLE NOTES

Double breasted military effects distinguish the newest coats. Washable satin corduroy is cited for resort wear. Fancy turns to rough and crinkle silks for the blouse. These silks are also a forerunner for spring. Capelet effects play an important role both in the dress and coat realm. The scintillant mode again prevails in evening fashions. Beaded boleros are especially noted. Contrast in color and fabric continues a favorite theme with the designer. Golden beige with brown is an effective color combination which is now being tried.
