STRANGE BUT TRUE Catholic Facts But Little Known

Illustrated text about Catholic facts: This is a survival of Catholic times when bread was placed on the shelves over the baptismal font for the benefit of the poor. It is to be seen in the old half-timbered church at Lower Peover, Cheshire, Eng. In Mohammedan territory, on the shore of the Bosphorus, this monument stands in commemoration and appreciation of the efforts of Pope Benedict XV to bring about peace and to alleviate the misery caused by the war. The Vatican Palace was not always the residence of the Popes. For about a thousand years subsequent to the 4th century the Lateran Palace in Rome now replaced by the present smaller building was the abode of the SOVEREIGN PONTIFFS. The Parish (Protestant) Church at Arundel, Sussex is divided by a wall only from the Catholic Chapel of the Duke of Norfolk. The wall is at the rear of the altar in each building.
