Father Kolping's Contribution To the Reconstruction of Society

(C. V. Service) In a large number of cities of our country there exist at the present time branches of a Catholic organization intended to foster the welfare of Catholic journeymen. Although the Kolping Society, so named from its founder, the venerable Father Kolping was planted in America...

It was in the industrial city of Li-benfeld he was granted his first opportunity to labor among young Catholic men of the working classes. After he had been called to Cologne (Catholic Journeymen Guild) came into existence, a providential organization which soon established branches in all parts of the German federation of that time, in Switzerland, and even in our own country...

While the old guilds were the economic, social and religious institutions which they were intended to be, the journeymen was a member of the family of the master guild...

Cultivation of Family Life. One gathers from these principles that Kolping's intention in establishing his new society "was to create an organization fitted to help in the preparation of a new social order, and that the spiritual remedy to be contributed by this organization was the cultivation of family life, for Kolping, one of the most distinguished leaders of the Catholic social movement in the nineteenth century...
