Crusade of Prayer and Penance Pastoral Letter Issued By BISHOP JOHN FRANCIS O'HERN, D.D.

A letter sent to the pastors of the diocese by Most Rev. John Francis O'Hern, Bishop of Rochester, based upon the Holy Father's Encyclical, "Caritas Christi"—"Christ's Charity," calls for public prayers and devout exercises of piety to be conducted throughout the diocese from Friday, June 3 to Friday, June 10, in every church, public and semi-public chapel, in college, high schools, academies and parochial schools.

Prayer for Peace. "Again the Pope asks that peace for all should be included in that prayer—a peace reaching out to men of every nation, that peace of which the Saviour spoke on the first Easter Sunday to His apostles and disciples: 'Peace be to you.' However, to pray for us, must join the spirit of penance and self-denial so that our prayers will be more readily heard and acceptable to God. This is nothing but the mortification of which we read constantly in the lives of the great men and women of the past, a fundamental part of the Christian life.

Prayer then and penance, says the Supreme Pontiff, are the two potent inspirations sent to us at this time by God that we may lead back to Him mankind that has gone astray and wanders about without a guide.
