Without removing him from his duties as tutor to the heir Louis XIV had appointed Fenelon Archbishop of Cambrai before many months of his service in the palace of Versailles. He was in great demand as a public orator and preacher and his fame in France grew by leaps and bounds.

Ever true to his vocation as a director of souls he was always ready to help the pupil for the confessional. His spirited correspondence reveals the thoughts who sought his spiritual guidance. In particular he became interested in a very pious and devoted young peasant, Madame Guyon. Unfortunately her piety was carried to unlawful extremes with the result that her chief work, a treatise on prayer, was condemned by the Church authorities. Fenelon was troubled by these things for the French Church because

Without changing countenance the Archbishop continued the ascent of his pulpit. With his own lips he read the condemnation pronounced by Rome and announced his unqualified submission as a loyal son of the Church. He then preached a sermon on our duty to obedience to higher
