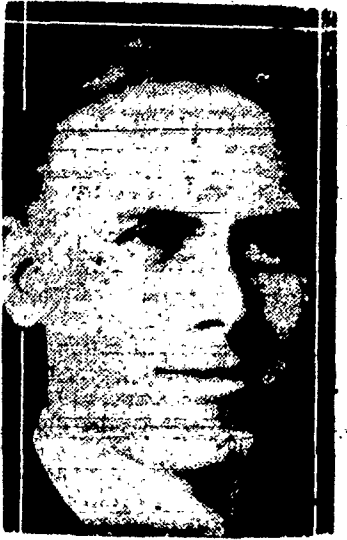

Robert D. Burns, Noted Newswriter Historian, Dies

Funeral services for Robert Daniel Burns, 59, historian, archaeologist and news writer, and twin brother of Rt. Rev. Msgr. George V. Burns, who died Tuesday night at his home, 350 Oxford Street, will be held today.

Mr. Burns recently retired as a news writer for The Times Union. His death followed a short illness. As a representative of the New York World, he covered for his news paper the suit brought by William Burnes, Albany Republican leader, against President Theodore Roosevelt in 1914.

He was born in Buffalo, April 4, 1872. He came to Rochester with the family in 1883 and was educated in the parochial school. In 1897 he was appointed Deputy United States Marshal and served three years. Following that he entered the newspaper field.
