HOW and WHAT TO SERVE HINTS FOR THE HOUSEWIFE

Shrimp a La Creole

- 1 No. 1 Can of Tomatoes 2 medium onions, sliced 1/2 green pepper

Slowly until onion is soft. Thicken with one tablespoon of flour, add one teaspoon of salt, one teaspoon of sugar and one tablespoon of butter. Then add one pound or two cans of shrimp which has been cooked and cleaned. Serve with a border of boiled rice.

The Junior Cook

- Of course I know all my Junior Cooks know what delightful things can be made of lady fingers, but I doubt very much if any of you have ever made lady fingers. Here is a recipe that is easy to follow, and the results are the most delectable. Chocolate Lady Fingers 2 eggs separated 6 tbs. milk 1 1/2 cup pastry flour 4 tps. baking powder 1 cup sugar 1 1/2 tsp. vanilla 5 tps. cocoa 1/2 tsp. salt Beat egg yolks until thick, add sugar gradually, then milk and vanilla, beating continuously. Stir in cocoa, baking powder and salt together. Add to egg yolks and stir until smooth. Fold in the stiffly beaten egg whites. Bake in moderate oven about ten minutes in greased lady finger tin or in a thin sheet that can be cut in strips three inches long and one inch wide. Makes one dozen. (Copyright, 1932, N. C. W. G.)
