HOW AND WHAT TO SERVE: In considering labor-saving meals, consider salmon for the main dish. Salmon is unsurpassed for summer meals. It may be served either hot or cold and is very easily prepared. In addition, it is usually a favorite with every member of the family, and for another reason, salmon is one of the fish that contains as great an amount of protein as meat, although in a much more digestible form. It may be used interchangeably with meat with no danger of cheating the family in the matter of food value.

Salmon Potato Salad 2 cups diced potatoes 1/2 cup French dressing 2 cups cold flaked salmon 1/2 tsp. celery salt lettuce 1-6 top paprika 2 hard boiled eggs, (finely chopped) 1 cup cooked peas 1/2 cup French dressing

Rowboat Salad Cut cucumber in half, lengthwise, scoop out center as much as possible. Mix one small can salmon, 1 stalk celery, chopped, 2 boiled eggs, diced, and mayonnaise. Use the cucumber shells for the boat, fill with the mixed salmon, use the celery heart for the man in the boat, the asparagus tips (2) for ears, and place on lettuce leaves for the waves.

Berry Pie Raspberries, blackberries, huckleberries, raspberries, blueberries, strawberries, elderberries, gooseberries, and cranberries make delicious pies. As they are very juicy special precautions must be taken to prevent soggyness of crust. The lower crust may be brushed with white of egg or sprinkled with 2 tbs. of flour. Prepare the berries by picking over and washing thoroughly. Both cooked and uncooked berries must be drained or the pie will be too juicy. (The juices of cooked or canned berries can be used in making beverages or gelatin desserts.) The usual rule is to use 3 cups berries, 1/2 cup sugar and 3 tbs. flour. Sprinkle half the flour on the bottom of the crust and the other half over the berries. It is far better to have too much flour in a berry pie than not enough because it is impossible to serve neat pieces of pie if the pie is too juicy.
