The Junior Cook

Every little girl takes pride in saying that she has made a cake. To make a good cake, of course, the directions must be followed very carefully. Before starting to mix the cake follow the suggestions listed below.
 First of all get the materials ready on the table. Then grease the pan. So that the oven is of the right heat. Then start mixing the cake. After the cake is taken from the oven sprinkle the top with powdered sugar. Then, last but not least, be sure to wash up all the dishes you have used.
PLAIN CAKE
 1-3 cup butter
 2 eggs
 1½ tsp. baking powder
 1½ cup flour
 1 cup sugar
 ¼ cup milk
 ¼ tsp. salt
 1 tsp. vanilla
 Cream butter; add sugar gradually and continue creaming until light; add eggs well beaten; flour, baking powder and salt alternately with milk; flavoring; beat well, turn into greased and floured cake pan and bake forty-five minutes.
