The Sisters of Notre Dame, who staff the Catholic Female Orphanage at Liverpool, a 111-year-old institution reduced the running expenses by \$700 during the year, following previous economies.

The Monastery located in Rochester belongs to the Order of Discalced Carmelites and is one of the twenty-six monasteries in the United States. Discalced means barefooted and is used to distinguish them from that branch which accepted certain reforms introduced in the year 1442.

Wherever located, the sanctuaries of Carmel are much frequented because of the numerous indulgences granted by Sovereign Pontiffs to the churches of the Order.

The Monastery here has felt the effects of the depression inasmuch as the Sisters depend upon the voluntary contributions of the people for their support, and we feel that we should do something to help them at this time.

Swiss Missionary Seized By Chinese Bandits

Rome. — (N.C.W.C. Files) — The Rev. Louis Paly, O.P., Swiss missionary of the Prefecture Apostolic of Tinchow, Fukien Province, China, has been taken by bandits, Tinchow is a mission territory of the German Province of Dominicans.

Father Paly was taken captive at Shanghai, center of the "Soviet Republic of Western Fukien," as the 12th Red Army claims the territory over which it dominates.

Missionaries of this province have been harassed by Reds for the past several years. Many times they were compelled to leave their stations. For a long period the German Dominicans had to remain with the American missionaries of Maryknoll at Kaying, across the Kiangtung border.
