We are passing on to our readers the following convincing explanation of the National Catholic Welfare Conference and its Lay Organizations Department...

What we should ask is, not what we shall get from the bishops' own organizations, but what we shall give to them.

"And this is the essentially Catholic and American attitude of mind. There is no doubt about the fact that the N. C. W. C. and its lay organizations, the N. C. C. M. and the N. C. C. W., have done much toward unifying the Catholic thought and influence of America..."

"Beyond that, its programs have brought far-reaching results in a hundred different instances. It has backed with its influence important legislation. It has warned against and helped to defeat legislation that would have been harmful to American life..."

"All of these things are merely the highlights of achievement. They are not the matter involved. What the N. C. C. M. and the N. C. C. W. have done for us Catholics is important. But the question now is rather: What can we Catholics do for them? What have we done and what shall we do?"

"Undoubtedly they are the official organizations sponsored by the bishops of the country. They are the method chosen by the bishops to bring the various lay organizations into closer harmony and, while leaving them free and self-governing within the limits of canon law, to coordinate them more and more to unified purpose and single-minded Catholic viewpoint."
