Conduct and Speech VULGARITY. The treatment of low, disgusting, unpleasant, though not necessarily evil subjects, should be subject always to the dictates of good taste...

1. COMPLETE NUDITY is never permitted. This includes nudity in fact or in silhouette, or any lecherous or licentious notice thereof...

Churches and Countries RELIGION. 1. No film or episode may throw ridicule on any religious faith.

NATIONAL FEELINGS. 1. The use of the flag shall be consistently respectful.

TITLES. Salacious, indecent or obscene titles shall not be used.

- 1. ACTUAL HANGINGS or electrocutions as legal punishments for crime. 2. THIRD-DEGREE methods. 3. BRUTALITY and possible gruesomeness.

To Oppose Censorship At its Chicago convention last week, the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer and Loew executive staff voted to budget \$100,000 for counter censorship propaganda during the coming year.

That the movie executives are fully cognizant of the wide effect of the drive for decency on the screen was evidenced at a sales meeting here this week.

Meanwhile the nation is watching with interest whether the promises made by Joseph Breen, decency mentor under Will Hays, to the Catholic Bishops' committee in Cincinnati two weeks ago will be carried out.

Throughout Nation While the bishops accepted Breen's proposal with thanks, they declared, nevertheless, that the campaign of the Legion of Decency will be spread to every community in the nation.

The section of the bishops' statement on this proposal reads: "The Committee has been pleased to receive these representatives and to learn from them of the renewed efforts toward enforcement of the industry's plan of self-regulation effective as of July 1, 1934, which has been decided upon."

In a widely syndicated article published on the coast during the past week an effort was made to convey the impression that not all Catholic bishops are behind the Legion of Decency crusade.

The appearance of the Pontiff was greeted with warm applause by the audience, which numbered such prominent personages as Senator Roberto Forgas Davanzani, editor of La Tribuna, the Hon. Umberto Guglielmotti, a member of Parliament and secretary of the National Association of Italian Journalists...

Pleased with the welcome accorded him, the Holy Father walked about the two vast halls and, approaching such of those assembled, gave his hand for them to kiss while Monsignor Pucci made the presentations.

Surpassed Expectations Following the reception, the Holy Father ascended to the throne and began his discourse, declaring that the audience, which, through information given him previously by Signor Vignoli, he expected to be imposing, surpassed all his expectations.

He then thanked them for the co-operation which they had lent to the success of the Holy Year.

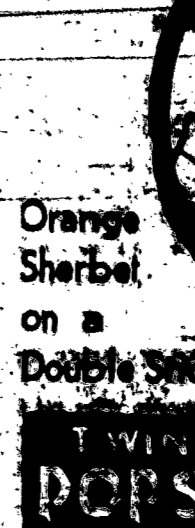
Band Concert Planned For Montecassini Church Plant
