## Catholic Action Summer School To Attract Sodalists

Directors and members of Parish and school Sodalities of the diocese of Rochester are making arrangements to attend the eastern division of the fourth annual Summer School of Catholic Action, to be conducted in New York from August 27 to September 1. Sessions will take place in co-operation with Fordham University, at College of St. Francis Xavier, 20 West 16th Street. A like Summer School is scheduled from August 10 to 22 in St. Louis, Mo.

Each day of the Summer School will open with general session followed by group (parish, college and high school meetings where general principles of Catholic Action organization and their practical application to particular problems will be explained. Class lectures and open forum discussion on the basis of unified groups will complete the scheduled program.

A night course will be offered in New York only, consisting of two intensive hours of work. This course is provided for those who cannot attend during the day.

## Activities of Central Bureau Conducted By Central Verein In St. Louis Will Be Outlined Here By Director Kenkel

One of the outstanding features of the convention of the Catholic Youth of America and of the National Catholic Women's Union to be held in this city August 19 to 22 will be the report of the activities of Central Bureau which will be made on Monday evening August 20 by Mr. F. Kenkel K. S. G., K. H. S., director of the Bureau.

For many years prior to 1908, the leaders of the Central Verein concluded that if a thorough study of the Social Question was to be made by the national, the state and the local divisions of the Central Verein there must be some central place where information could be gathered and given to the various units of the national organization. It was from this conclusion that the Central Bureau located at St. Louis, Mo., was formed in 1908. Mr. Kenkel was chosen as its director and has guided the bureau for more than twenty-five years.

Lauded by Prelate Archbishop Glennon of St. Louis, who has been a strong advocate of the Bureau, speaking recently of its activities, among other things said: "I have followed with interest the development of the Bureau during these latter years, and I recognize it now as one of the most useful and practical agencies of the Church and Catholic society. Combining, as it does, intelligent direction, wide scope of action, it is careful to select subjects that are practical, whose proper treatment is of vital importance to the community. It combines at once a publishing house, a school of Catholic sociology, a center of propaganda and a bureau of exchange for the many Catholic social activities, seeking to serve the workmen in the city, the farmer in the country, and to make for the one and the other their Christian home life possible and comfortable. It never forgets the One Who had compassion on the multitude and taught wherein lay true prosperity. While it remains true to its present purposes, the Central Bureau has a permanent mission."

Mr. Kenkel will tell of these various activities and what the Central Bureau has accomplished within the past year. Those who have heard him in the past years, the committee in charge states, know what a treat it is to hear from the people of Rochester that take advantage of the invitation to be present and listen to the report.

What the members of the Central Verein think of the importance of the Central Bureau is shown by the fact that an endowment fund of over \$200,000 has already been raised, the income from which is to be used to run the bureau. As this fund grows from year to year, the work of the Bureau will be progressively enlarged.

While the Central Bureau and its work has not been generally known, it has quietly been doing a remarkable work throughout its history. It keeps in close touch with all state and local branches, and also with the various parts of the world where attention is given particularly to the study of the social question. No group is better known at the legislative halls of the national capital and at the legislative halls of the different states. It keeps a close watch on all legislation that affects Catholic interests and the welfare of society in general.

The Central Bureau is a veritable powerhouse of Catholic sociological principles and keeps abreast of the times in all that pertains to Christian social principles. It publishes a monthly called "Central-Blatt and Social Justice" which has been declared by such eminent members of the Hierarchy as Bishop Boyle of Pittsburgh, Bishop Rummel of Omaha and Archbishop Glennon of St. Louis as the outstanding publication on the question of sociology from the Catholic viewpoint. It makes a study especially of the two great labor Encyclicals, that of Pope Leo XIII on the Condition of the Working Classes and that of Pope Pius XI on the Reconstruction of Society. It selects experts to write upon these letters of the Popes, so that the members of the Central Verein may have accurate

## Mass For Fr. Nelligan Celebrated On Fiftieth Ordination Anniversary


