PAYING BILLS BY CHECK. WHEN you pay a bill by check the company or individual who receives the check deposits it in his bank and his account is credited with the amount of the check. The bank then proceeds to collect the check from the bank on which it is drawn. The collection is easily made through the facilities of the local Clearing House if the check is drawn on a bank in the same city. If the check is drawn on a bank in a distant city the check is sent through the mails for collection, a transaction which may require several days to complete. If the bank in which the check is deposited is a member of the Federal Reserve System, as the Lincoln-Alliance is, collection of checks is more rapidly accomplished through the Federal Reserve Bank. When the account on which the check has been drawn has been properly charged, the cancelled check—after being photographed for the bank files by a Recordak—is returned to the maker.
