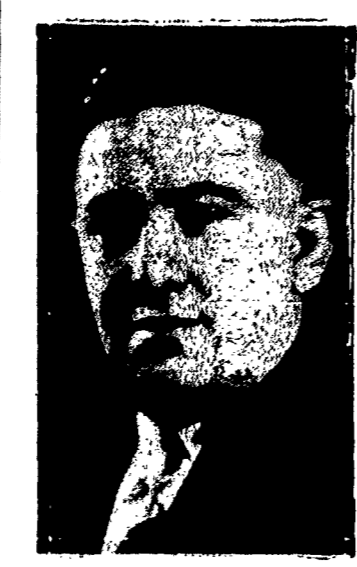

Holy Name Campaign Nears 3000 As Parishes Continue To Report

That the Holy Name Societies of the Diocese have not ceased their efforts for subscriptions for the CATHOLIC COURIER with the closing of their formal campaign last Friday, is evident from the number of additional subscriptions that continued to pour into headquarters of the Diocesan Holy Name Union this week, making a total of 2900 new subscriptions to date.

St. Monica's, Rochester, added 11 subscriptions to go into fifth place in the standings with a total of 133. St. Patrick's, Elmira, added 16 subscriptions to climb into the select 100-class with a total of 109 subscriptions and take second place among the parishes outside the episcopal city.

Other additions were made by Sacred Heart, Rochester; St. Francis de Sales, Geneva; St. Theodore's, Gates; St. Paul's, Honeoye Falls; St. Agnes, Avon.

Among the parishes reporting for the first time were: St. Rose, Lima; St. Michael's, Montezuma and St. Patrick's, Macedon.

Our records show 82 parishes have participated in the campaign to date and that 57 of those have reported to subscriptions or more, said Roy Crissy, secretary of the union last night.
