Recommended Recipes

Mince-meat. One pound meat from lower part of round (or boiling piece of meat), 1/2 lb. suet. Cover with cold water, add 1 tsp. salt and let simmer gently until very tender.

Mushroom Sauce. Take a piece of the tail end of the sirloin steak and fry it in a skillet; when it is fried brown, remove from pan and pour 1/2 cup cut-up mushrooms into the grease; then remove pan to back of stove until it cools some; when cooled add 1 cup hot water and boil again.
