"I was arrested on August 7, 1933, in Juarez," Father Oranga said. "I was charged with refusing to say 'No' to the church at San Lorenzo, Chihuahua. It was placed in my jail with criminals for two hours and a fine of \$100 was assessed. I refused to pay. After a conference with the President Municipal, I was released without payment of the fine. I refused to celebrate Mass in the church due to the fact that it was in charge of a person most grata to me."
