Two Native Girls Swim Shark-Infested Water, Walk 12 Miles To Mass Vanappa, New Britain (NCWC Files)-Two little 12-year-old native girls of the Lis Islands, north of New Ireland in the Bismarck Archipelago, swam through a shark-infested channel and then walked 12 miles to the Catholic mission of Mass to attend Mass and receive the Sacraments.

Late in getting started, they had been left behind by mistake when the other Christians set out in canoes for the island of Malin, where the mission is located. When the priest in charge, Father Neuhaus, of the Sacred Heart Mission of Hiltrop, reproved them for their apparent foolishness of entering the water where there were sharks, they replied that they had no fear of the sharks but that the strong current between the islands bothered them and made the crossing difficult.
