banquet Michael Williams pleaded for co-operation and united action on the part of Catholics, Protestants and Jews. He issued a warning that the time was near at hand when the above must stand shoulder to shoulder against atheism and communism. Otherwise, Russian and Mexican propaganda would soon undermine the principles of life, liberty and happiness in our country. The contest is and will be between those believing and those rejecting God.

Contrasts Speakers Referring to Mureno, Father Groden said: "Last Sunday night two divergent camps were in town. At the time the attack on Father Williams advocated peace and love before a large audience, saying Protestant, Jew and Catholic should forget their doctrinal differences and march together against the common foe of organized international atheism."

"Across the city in a Christian church, another orator, calling himself a Catholic, berated the mother that had nurtured him at her breast from youth and blamed the church in Mexico for much of the unhappiness that prevails there. It befits any natural son to besmirch the name of the mother that brought him up, even though she fall ever so short in the fulfillment of her duties."

Herbert Bolton, a Protestant historian, can best answer his charges. One of the marvels of the history of the modern world is the way in which Spain took possession of the Caribbean Archipelago and by rapid and steady advance spread her culture, her religion, her law and her language over more than half of the two American continents. In the English colonies, the only good natives were dead Indians in the Spanish colonies it was thought worthwhile to improve the natives for this life as well as for the next. Hence an almost complete extinction of the American Indian today.

"Millions of natives were converted, hundreds of missions were established, innumerable Indian villages were protected and native languages were returned to writing by the missionaries. The college of Santa Cruz was founded in Mexico City in 1535 in 1561 the University of Mexico and the University of Lima were chartered. Harvard was established in 1636 one hundred years after the University of Vera Cruz. America is indebted to the Spanish for religious and cultural influence."

Dr. M. J. Mahoney, a Catholic priest, said in part: "A succession of events during the past few weeks has excited me as a Catholic priest to say a word for the Catholic Church, whose members number thousands in our community. Whether statements have been made by a Bishop, a business man or a man interested in oil, the Catholic Church must defend herself in the cause of humanity."

"I intend to prove that there is persecution in Mexico, that churches are closed and one priest is pointed for thousands of souls. These who are ignorant of the fact, and others who will not admit, are determined not to be convinced."

SEE PRELATE IN TORONTO ENTHRONED

Toronto (NCWC) - The youngest Archbishop in North America was enthroned here Mar. 20 to head the see of Toronto. Archbishop J. C. McGuigan, now only 49 years of age, formerly Bishop of Regina, was installed in St. Michael's Cathedral as successor to the late Archbishop Neil McNeil.

His Excellency the Most Rev. Andrew Casullo, Apostolic Delegate to Canada and Newfoundland, performed the ceremony in the presence of more than a score of prelates from all parts of Canada, representatives of the Dominion, Provincial and municipal governments and before a congregation as large as that more than 1,000, unable to gain admittance to the Cathedral, were obliged to listen to the service by loudspeakers.

Present for the ceremony were Archbishop McGuigan's mother, Mrs. Annie McGuigan, of Charlottetown, P.E.I., his sister, Sister St. George, of Villa Marie Convent, Toronto, and his brother, Dr. Martin McGuigan, of Charlottetown.

Prominent among the laymen attending the ceremony were Lieutenant-Governor Herbert Bruce of Ontario and Sir William Mulock, Chief Justice of Ontario.

Archbishop M. J. O'Brien, of Kingston, was present with Archbishop G. Forbes, Ottawa, Archbishop T. O'Donnell, Halifax, and Archbishop Mooney.

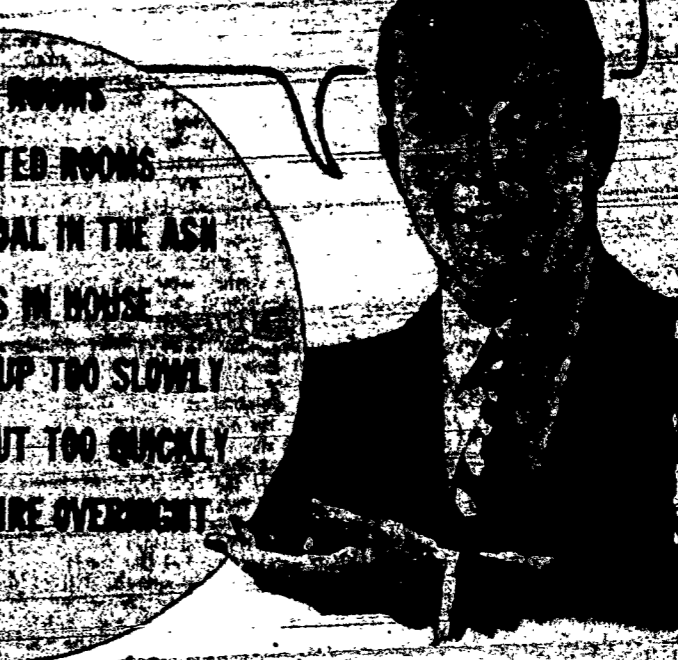
