## 'Queen's Work' Declares that Tourist Money in Mexico Pays To Persecute 9 of 10 Citizens

National Sodality Official Organ Edited by Father Lord, National Director, Pleads 'Stop the Funds which Pay These Nerov' Salaries'

This summer some large international conventions, notably, we have been told, those of the Rotary and the Lions Clubs, are meeting in Mexico and thus taking American money into Mexico pays a front page story in the March issue of 'The Queen's Work', edited by the Rev. Daniel A. Lord, S. J., national director of the Sodality movement.

Catholic members of these organizations, the article states, will naturally be expected to attend and to bring their money to help keep the conventions in Mexico.

## VATICAN CITY PRESS DISPLAY PLANS READY

(Continued from Page 9) In charge of a coordinating center constituted in the respective country; these national centers will have the liberty to choose and coordinate activities within the general limits of the plan of the Exhibition.

With the object of facilitating their activity, the Central Organizing Committee has distributed suggestions for the collection of exhibits. The chief points to be illustrated are suggested: (a) progressive development of the national Catholic Press and the 'internationalization' of the press; (b) principal press campaign carried on in each country in defense of the Church and her institutions, of the family, of schools, of social order, etc.; (c) the press of the Catholic Press of the country with statistical data 'drawn up' in such a way to define the real situation; (d) all the initiatives, however modest, of the press of the country which should be worthy of study and imitation; (e) the services that the Catholic Press renders the Church and Catholic life in each country, especially in the moral, civil and social progress.

In these national departments copies of periodicals, journals and magazines published in each country will be exhibited as far as they serve the reconstruction of the general picture representing the best development and present state of the Catholic Press in any given country.

A special part of this section will be devoted to the mission countries for whom, under the auspices of the Sacred Congregation of Propaganda, is being collected characteristic and original material which will be a great surprise to many, since it will bring to light problems which are not generally known.

In the Second Section room will be found the special pavilion in which will be shown some great journalistic or editorial undertakings of some press institution of exceptional importance.

The 'Specialized Section' will contain special categories of publications grouped according to their contents. The places of honor will be reserved for the publications of the Catholic Action and following this the publications of Catholic organizations, institutions, publications of the religious Orders and Congregations, cultural reviews such as theological, philosophical, historical, scientific, literary and artistic reviews, etc.

For the preparation of material regarding Catholic Action the operator has been requested of Central Directions of Catholic Action, Youth Associations and Women's Unions of the various countries.

Publications of a missionary character in European countries and America will be collected in a special department of the Pontifical Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

In the case of the Sacred Congregation for the Oriental Church will be exhibited for the first time all periodical publications of Catholics of Oriental Rites.

Under the auspices of the Sacred Congregation of Seminaries and Universities the exhibition of periodical publications of schools and particularly of Catholic Universities will be arranged.

Another special department will collect and illustrate the periodical publications of Religious Orders and Congregations.

A film is being prepared to illustrate in all its details the organization and life of a great modern newspaper.

The organizing committee is formed as follows: President, Count Giuseppe Dalla Torre, Editor of the 'Osservatore Romano'; Vice-President, Count Franco Ratti, Commendatore Bartolomeo Nogara and Commendatore Leo Castelli, and Secretary, Monsignor Giuseppe Monti.

Count Dalla Torre belongs to an illustrious family of the Venetian nobility and was for many years editor of the 'Catholic paper', 'La Libertà di Padua'. When Pope Pius XI organized the Catholic Action in Italy, Count Dalla Torre was called to be president of the Unione Popolare among the Catholics of Italy and gave proof in that office of excellent organizing qualities. He was called to the direction of the 'Osservatore Romano' by the retiring Pontiff, after the Unione Popolare was amalgamated with Catholic Action.

Count Ratti, son of the Pope's brother, is the President of the Central Council of the Vatican City. Commendatore Nogara is Director of the Papal Museums and Galleries. He is an authority in the field of art and has been for some years President of the Council of Administration of the 'Osservatore Romano'.

As to Yugoslavia, 'some progress' is reported to have been made. On Italy the authors of the Almanac discharge the full vials of their anger, saying: 'In that country of darkness are the headquarters of the Roman Catholic hierarchy. That tool of the devil has its representatives in all departments of the government.'
