Marking Devices Require Special Ink, Says Morse

As a guarantee of merit and quality, many manufacturers today put their trade-marks on, not only wood and metal, but fruit, eggs, meat and poultry with either a rubber stamp or stencil.

A good grade of rubber stamp ink is made with a glycerine base and will not damage the rubber in the least, but rubber stamp ink, on the other hand, does not work satisfactory on stamps having metal printing surface or die.
