Sisters Return After Visiting Rome and Vatican

Corning—Returning recently from a six-week tour of Italy, Sister M. Gregory, principal of St. Mary's School here, and Sister M. Carmelite of Rochester, reported a store of enjoyable and elevating travel experiences. The Very Rev. James O'Reilly, Ph. D., of New York City, had charge of the party of 28 American women, which Sister Gregory and Sister Carmelite were members. The ship on which they sailed, the S. S. Rex, arrived in Nice April 7. A motor trip over the Corniche Drive, was followed by visits to Genoa, Milan, Padua, Venice, and Florence. The party also visited the famous religious shrines of Sienna and Assisi. In Rome the travelers remained for seven days, attending the ceremonies of Holy Week. The Catacombs, the Coliseum, the Pantheon, the Palazzo di Senator, and St. Peter's Cathedral were for the world-renowned places which the party viewed. The group attended Mass at St. Peter's on Sunday, celebrated by the Holy Father. On the following Tuesday an audience with His Holiness Pope Pius XI was granted the travelers. While in Rome, Sisters Carmelite and Gregory called upon Rev. McNamara of Corning, who is attending the North American College in Rome. Sister Gregory also visited a brother of Nicholas Mizoni, of Corning. McNamara's brother is a member of a brotherhood of teachers at St. Gabriel's College.

Sacred Hearts Order Priest, Brother Return From Hawaiian Posts

Rev. Joseph Verschuren, SS. CC., Brother Jules Haegen, SS. CC., members of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, arrived at the Monastery of the Sacred Hearts in Fairhaven, Massachusetts, on Sunday, May 5, 1935, after a tour of duty in the Hawaiian Islands. Both missionaries sailed for Europe last week where they will spend a short vacation with relatives. Fr. Joseph has been laboring in Hawaii for over twelve years as assistant to Bishop Stephen Alencaster, SS. CC., and his predecessor, Bishop Libertus Boeyenss, SS. CC., at the Cathedral in Honolulu. He is pastor of two churches in Kilauea also. Brother Jules volunteered to go to Molokai in 1920, where he undertook the work for which Fr. Damien, SS. CC., has become so famous; namely, the care of lepers. The first eight years of his life on the island were spent in washing and dressing the wounds of the lepers at the hospital, but for the past seven years he has had charge of fifty leper boys at the orphanage. There his work is similar to what he did at the hospital.
