sailed Statesmanship, not interference is the need of the hour.

Representative Penery says that the committee has taken its labor "in a judicial spirit" and that "it has been particularly impressed by the testimony of a number of Protestant ministers and Jewish leaders, both rabbis and laymen, who have undertaken a first-hand investigation of the persecution which has been going on in Mexico in such an acute form during the past twelve months."

"As a member of the minority party," Representative Penery also says, "I wish to express my gratitude to both Democrats and Republicans who without regard for political party have seen the necessity of insisting upon religious and academic freedom for Americans in Mexico. The cause of religious liberty whether it concerns Jews or Christians is greater than party. The members of the committee have other suggestions from members of both parties which will be given due consideration as the cause progresses."

MSGR. FORD NAMED BISHOP IN CHINA POST

Maryknoll, N. Y. (NCWC)—The Rt. Rev. Msgr. Francis X. Ford, M.M., Præfatus Apostolicus of Kiating, territory in 1929, and a member of the first band of Maryknoll Missionaries who set out for China in September, 1918, has been named by His Holiness Pope Pius XI to be Bishop of the newly created Vicariate Apostolic of Kiating, according to word received here.

Bishop-elect Ford is the third member of Maryknoll to be elevated to the Episcopacy. The other two members are the Most Rev. James E. Walsh, M.M., of Cumberland, Md., who was made Bishop of the Vicariate Apostolic of Kiating, China, in 1927, and the Most Rev. James A. Walsh, M.M., of Cambridge, Mass., Founder and Superior General who was made Titular Bishop of Siena in 1933.

Since going to China, Bishop-elect Ford has fallen into the hands of bandits on three separate occasions in 1924, he and other Catholics were seized by bandits while leaving the French concession at Kiating for the interior. He and the others were robbed of their money and their belongings, some of which the French authorities later recovered. Two years later, bandits boarded a boat on which he was traveling for Kiating, killed the captain, stripped the ship of valuables, and then permitted it to proceed.
