

Usually two by fours are used for side forms, being held in place by stakes driven along the outside. To stake sure that water will drain off the walk should be sloped toward one side. A pitch of % inch to 1/4 inch is satisfactory for a walk feet wide.

For convenience in building and to provide for expansion and con-traction of jetres, walks should be divided at 4 to 8 feet intervals with partition strips placed at right angles to the side form.
