danger was threatening, or the inadequacy of the measures adopted to defend order in the face of lawlessness. It is not for us to judge those who are struggling with their words and actions, but we must assess the guilt of those whom they used as tools in carrying out their mission and commands. Our duty is to adore Almighty God and implore Him the Divine gift of Peace."
