Indirectly by federal law to advertise their agencies they rely on just such publicity and helpful respectability as Concord gave them. This commercialism of vice is more menacing to morals than bootlegging of drinks or drugs. Its subtle and insidious campaigning is clearly out of proportion to its promised benefits to womanhood. For every alleged physical or social advantage there are incalculable moral wrecks, a menace to social and civic safety.

Sponsor Misguided
The heart appeal for suffering humanity is but a pretext to deceive the public. In the annals of barbaric warfare it is recorded that brutal invaders first stealthily seized some of the women of the group they were to attack. They were compelled to march in the van of the onslaught so that regard for the unfortunate women might handicap the foe. Today the forces of a commercialized and continuing evil are attacking the moral character of our youth and the moral strength of our nation. They, too, depend upon the heart appeal in behalf of overburdened, womanhood in the van, and with the approving cheers of misguided and short-sighted sisters who jeopardize their respectability in making vice respectable, the forces of a continuing and destructive evil strengthen their attack from such assaults may God protect the real friends of overburdened woman-kind and promising youth, protect the more integrity and good name of our New Hampshire, protect our nation, against which too many like forces of destruction are raining hideous heads.

Secular Paper Urges Pope as Mediator To Avert European War

Cincinnati (NC)—Saying that His Holiness Pope Pius XI "would seem to be a logical personage to act as mediator," an editorial in the Cincinnati Times-Star says that "if the League of Nations fails, the Pope will be the last hope of civilization to avert a needless war for Italian expansion that may involve all of Europe."

"The efforts of Pius XI for peace recall events of the World War," the editorial says, pointing to the efforts of Pope Benedict XV "to arrive at a stable and honorable peace for all." "But," the editorial continues, "the warring nations paid no attention to Pope Benedict. They went on until they killed 2,000,000 more men and injured probably another 10,000,000. Pope Benedict had warned the nations that a condition of war would be a useless massacre. History concludes that he was right. The nations settled the war to end wars in their own way and still there is no hope of lasting peace."
