## DEDICATION SERMON

Delivered by the Rev. John B. Sullivan, pastor of St. John the Evangelist Church, Rochester, on the occasion of the dedication of St. Ignatius Loyola Church, Tuesday, September 17.

"HE THAT IS OF GOD HEAR THE WORDS OF GOD" MATTHEW 14:7  
I feel certain that I may speak for all the priests who have come to this dedication when I congratulate you and your pastor upon the completion of this beautiful temple of the Most High God. It will stand forever as a monument to the self-sacrifice of this congregation as well as to the zeal and untiring ability of your beloved pastor. Pastor and people, shepherd and flock, have every reason to rejoice today, and may your joy and happiness beget a loyalty that will sustain the work of your parish for all the years to come. All the ministers of God who may labor among you.

As we behold today this structure in all the newness and freshness of its beauty, we look back over the history of Christian civilization and marvel at the magnificent structure that have been built in the Old World and in the New. The very genius of man exulting himself in the masterpiece of architecture that we call "CHURCH." These rare structures of stone and marble were made possible by the zeal of people founded upon enlightened Faith, people who were of God and who heard the words of God. Today we are privileged to witness the quality and enduring nature of Faith as compared to the ages that have passed. You remember that scene in the Gospel which presents our Divine Lord addressing a great gathering of His people in the Temple. He refutes the vile charge made by His enemies that He is not the Son of God. He bravely challenges them and justly condemns them. His words are "I build my house upon a rock, and whatsoever I will shall stand. And I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." He had healed the ruler's son, multiplied the loaves and fishes, and walked upon the water. Hence, many had come to believe that He was the promised Messiah. Many listened to Him with reverent attention, and His leadership and pledged Him their loyalty. Some others threw stones at Him.

There is not one of us but wishes that he too might have been present in the Temple on that day to drink in the words of the gentle and humble and yet fearless and majestic Christ. We confidently assure ourselves that we would not have listened to and believed the calumnies of His enemies as some of the crowd there seems to have done. And taken up stones to cast at Him. Perhaps we would have been hostile to His enemies and loyal to His Cause. But we still have our chance, for Christ still lives and moves among you from whatever land or people you have wandered here, were a pilgrim at the shrine of Mystery, for there all men are one man. You bowed your head.

the poison of false teaching, of false views, of false ideals that have sprung from the pagan literature and fables of our day. To this poison, has partly obscured our minds' vision of God's eternal truth, and so partly paralyzed the faith that is in us. We may not, as did the Jews on that day, cry out to cast as Him. But 'faith' do we, as they did before they were confirmed in the faith, as we now are, cry out in the language of daily conduct, as well as with the songs of our lips: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord!" Under the chilling fog of false teaching the fires of our faith have burned low, and so give out little light and less warmth.

May this new church with the sound doctrine of Jesus Christ as against the paganism of the present day be ever an inspiration to all who come within its sacred walls. For the faith gives here, and preached here, will be in your hearts a genuine excitement for the name and cause of Christ our King. "He that is of God heareth the words of God." And to be fully of our Lord, we must accept fully the words of God. No reservations, no limitations, no selectivity. But go the whole way with Christ, who came that you might have life and have it more abundantly.
