PRIVATE CHARITY IS NEEDED IN CARING FOR NATION'S POOR

DIOCESAN DIRECTORS STATE

(Continued from Page 1)

The first meeting of the conference, that of the Directors of the National Conference was held Friday.

"During the depression," the Directors' statement said, "our principal care has been for those whom we deprived of the bread of life. We should not forget them as times become better. We should remember that many of them will never be able to take their places in industrial society and must be taken care of by the Government as part of its permanent program.

"The United States of today is a country with vast industries that employ millions of people. If the Government does not establish some degree of restraint over these industries then the whole nation will continue to be economically and socially unstable. Government must see to it that small business firms and wage earners get a fair return in markets dominated by powerful organizations of capital.

"The Federal Government cannot abandon the field of direct relief until we know more about the extent to which the work program provides for the needs of the unemployed and the ability of States and local communities to take care of the unemployed.

Catholic Workers' Duty

"As business conditions improve there is a danger that we may return to a hard, rigid attitude towards the poor and the handicapped Catholic social workers, as well as others, must at all times use their influence to see that sufficient funds are provided for the relief of the poor and that they are administered in a helpful and sympathetic way.

"The whole tendency in our time is toward adoption of definite rules of conduct in industry and business relationships. Such rules in economic life are in the last analysis the rules of justice and Christian teaching. They are part of the age-old teaching of the Church. They represent distinct trends away from many of the policies of the nineteenth century individualism, materialism and the selfishness of the weak against the predatory.

"It must be remembered that there is no class of which the depression has taken a heavier toll than that of the unemployed youth of our country. Year by year a large number of them have been leaving school and college without any hope of securing gainful employment. For them the depression means a loss of all spiritual development. The Federal Government has initiated a national program for unemployed youth.

"The unemployed youth of our country may remain in school longer. It is planning special employment opportunities for them. It is planning to extend its youth programs.

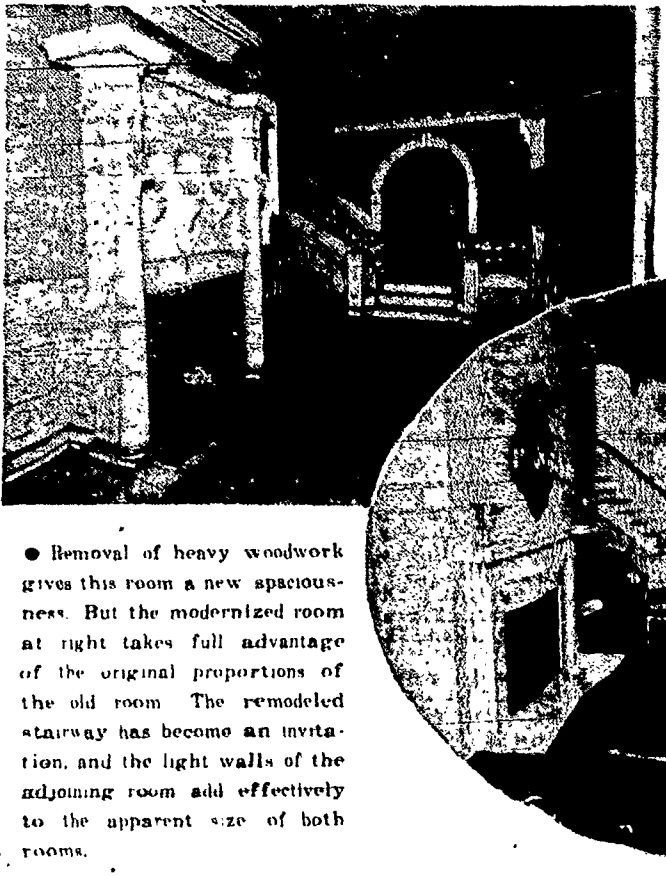

HOME IMPROVEMENTS



● Removal of heavy woodwork gives this room a new spaciousness. But the modernized room at right takes full advantage of the original proportions of the old room. The remodeled stairway has become an invitation, and the light walls of the adjoining room add effectively to the apparent size of both rooms.

Do you stop to count the number of times you go up and down the stairs? A major consideration in any home rebuilding project should be the stairs in your house, and necessarily because of their decorativeness but for their ease in climbing. The angle of ascent is known as the rake of the stair. This rake depends upon the ratio between the riser and the tread. The angle of ascent should be from 19 to 30 degrees.

Ethiopia Missionaries Not Identified With American Red Cross
Washington (AP)—Reports from Addis Ababa that the Ethiopian Government has resigned permission to travel to the Ogaden front granted to a Red Cross unit commanded by Dr. P. W. Hookman of the American Presbyterian Hospital because the missionaries had insisted on the right to preach and convert troops along with their medical work have brought the common here that the unit referred to does not in any way represent the American Red Cross.

The 42 Red Cross units throughout the world, it was pointed out, are organized on a national basis and each has an official character to a greater or lesser degree. The international treaties covering the work of the Red Cross treaties which Ethiopia recently adhered to—provide that its work shall be carried on without regard to race, color or creed.

In view of Ethiopia's adherence to the Red Cross treaties, the stand of that Government with relation to the mingling of missionary work with medical activities was to be expected, individuals here believe.
