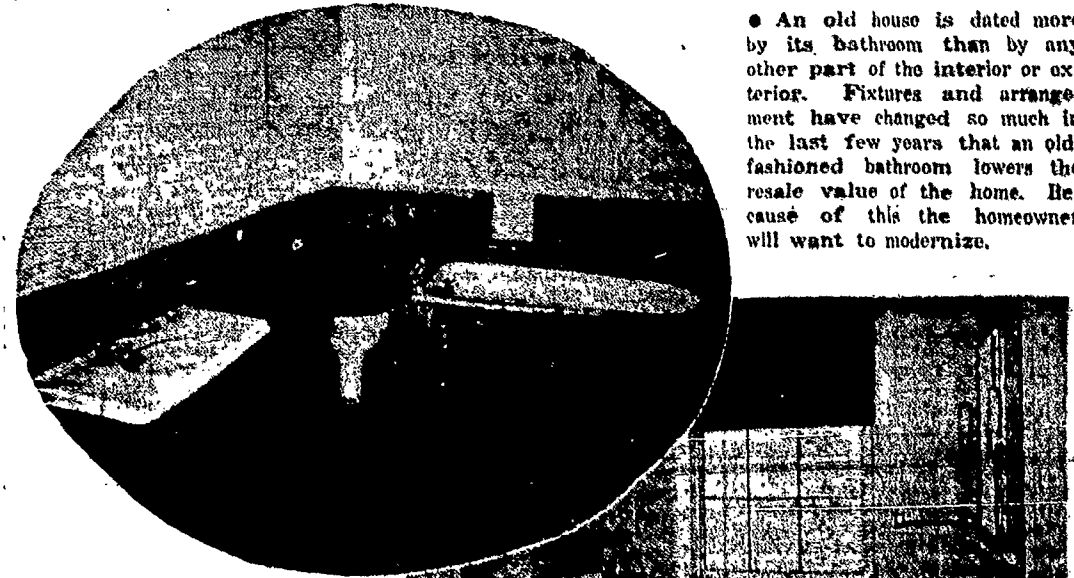

ANOTHER MILLION DOLLAR PLANT IN PROSPECT FOR R. G. and E. CO.

With one, one-million dollar electric generating plant about ready for operation, another is being planned. Herman Russell, president of the Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation, told a group of guests of the company including city officials and newspapermen, Thursday of last week in the newly erected plant at Platt Street and Brown's Race.

Improving business conditions was given by Mr. Russell as the reason for a growing demand for electric power.

"It is practically certain this plant will have to be duplicated next year," said the utility president at a dinner for the guests on the top floor of the plant in full view of the giant boiler running through all floors. "The power demand is showing a rapid gain, and is reaching toward the 1929 peak. Increasing the generating output becomes necessary because the company is now forced to purchase electricity for resale."

Some \$500,000 went to Rochester workmen in the construction of the present plant, Mr. Russell stated, and nearly a half-million more went into materials and equipment. He had insisted that contractors use all Rochester labor with the exception of key workers and he said there had been no labor trouble in connection with the building.

Guests before the dinner were taken, one by one, by a chute through a chute into the interior of the huge boiler in the plant. This huge combustion chamber, in which the guests were addressed by Superintendent Edgar R. Crofts, is 85 feet, 10 inches high.

The plant marks a notable advance in the evolution of steam power generation of electricity. Mr. Crofts announced. When the original plant was built more than 40 years ago the boilers were the best of that day. They were heated by furnaces, fired with coal shoveled by hand and carried steam pressure of 75 pounds.

The present boiler is designed for 750 pounds pressure, will generate 250,000 pounds of steam per hour and will consume 24 tons of coal per hour under full load. The steam passing through turbines connected to electric generators, will develop 21,000 kilowatts.
