 tury and a half has been the symbol of the principles of liberty of conscience, of religious freedom and equality before the law and these concepts are deeply engrained in our national character.  
 "It is true that other nations may, as they do, enforce contrary rules of conscience and conduct. It is true that policies that may be passed under flag of other nations are beyond our jurisdiction. Yet in our inner individual lives we can never be indifferent, and we assert for ourselves complete freedom to embrace, to profess and to observe the principles for which our flag has, so long been the lofty symbol. As it was so well said by James Madison, "We hold it for a fundamental and inalienable truth that religion and the manner of discharging it can be directed only by reason and conviction, not by force or violence."  
 "This statement, I now reiterate to you.
