(Continued from Page 1) We are the news from Mexico, unbiased and without mutilation. We resolve that the united strength of all the affiliations of the council be used to protest to our government against the inhuman treatment of our coreligionists by the political dictators of Mexico. We further resolved: That the National Council of Catholic Women extend to the organizations of Catholic Women and of Catholic Parents in our neighbor country Mexico, and renew our pledge to give to them our encouragement in the heroic efforts they are making in defense of essential fundamental rights and liberties of the individual, of the family and especially of the child.

Therefore, we are profoundly grateful to the Bishops of our country for the timely publication of their historical documents and current studies on the bolshevistic character of the National Revolutionary Party of Mexico. We recommend the excellent reporting of the N. C. C. W. News Service which continues to provide news from Mexico even against the tremendous obstacle of Mexican censorship.
