(Continued from Page 1) ligion of their children, they are within their rights.

To a Catholic there is no true religion other than the Catholic religion, and for this reason, it as not licit to accept or to recognize any education that is not Catholic

Encyclical Teachings The third, fourth and fifth points stressed are quoted from Pope Plus XI's Encyclical of Christian Edu-cation of Youth:

"Every forms of pedagogic naturalism which in any way excludes or weakens super-netural Christian formation in the teaching of youth, is false. Every, method of education founded, wholly or in part, on the denial or forgetfulness of original sin and of grace, and relying on the sole powers of human nature, is

"Far too common is the error of those who propagate a so-called sex-education, falsely imagining they can forcerm youths against the dangers of sensuality by means - rurely natural, such as a foolhardy initiation and precautionary instruc-tion for all indiscriminately, even in public, and, worse still, by exposing them at an early age to the occasion, in order to accustom them, so it is argued, and as it were to

harden them against such dangers. "Falsa also and harmful to Christian education is the so-called method of 'co-education' This too. by many of its supporters, is founded upon naturalism and the denial of original sin . There is not in nature itself, which fashions the two quite different in organism. in temperament, in abilities, anything to suggest that there can be or ought to be promiscuity, and much less equality, in the training of the two sexes."

Sixth, the Pestoral quotes from the Apostolic Delegate's instruction to Mexican Catholics of last January, and from various pronouncements of the Mexican Hierarchy to show that Catholics cannot rightfully attend or send their children to either public or private schools so iong as the requirements of Article 3 of the Mexican Constitution are in force, and that parents who keep their children in the Socialist schools are "committing a very grave mortal sin which cannot be absolved in Confession until the children are withdrawn from these establishments." It cites further the words of His Holiness Pope Pius XI.
