Washington. In spite of the many demands made on them they succeeded in placing at the disposal of the National Council of the Foreign Missions of the United States a sum greater than that of the previous year, namely, \$1,100,000.

This National contribution, he said, was to be sent to the Superior General Council in Rome, together with the contributions from 60 other nations and distributed among the Catholic Missions of the world. Last year the contribution was \$1,000,000, a considerable sum, yet less than a tenth of what it required for the support of the Foreign Missions of the Catholic Church, Monks, Nuns and Priests.

The Secretary reported that preparations for the 1936 Missionary Exhibition are well advanced and said that there was every indication that it would prove the most successful and representative yet organized by the Pontifical World. It was decided that the Society should again conduct the Course in Tropical Medicine for Catholic Missions, which will be held during the coming summer.

His Eminence Emmanuel Cardinal Suhard, Archbishop of Rheims, has blessed the new chimneys of the cathedral in a gift from John D. Rockefeller, Jr., replacing the chimneys destroyed by the Germans in September, 1914.

Thanks to an ingenious electrical apparatus, the chimneys strike every note of the scale and play on the hour. The melody can be heard in every part of the new rebuilt city. There are 14 bells in all, giving every tone and half-tone of an octave. Speaking bells, each bell can be used to sound at least nine distinct notes, some an octave below, others an octave above, with the result that intricate and difficult melodies can be executed on the chimneys.

The chime bell weighs 2,650 pounds and is an exact replica of the one which replaced it in 1880. It is used for announcing the hours in the note of El and is surrounded with decorative symbols of the royal houses of France, many members of which were crowned in Rheims Cathedral. There is an appropriate inscription on the bell, in part: "Take my name, I am Jeanne, like my predecessor of 1880."

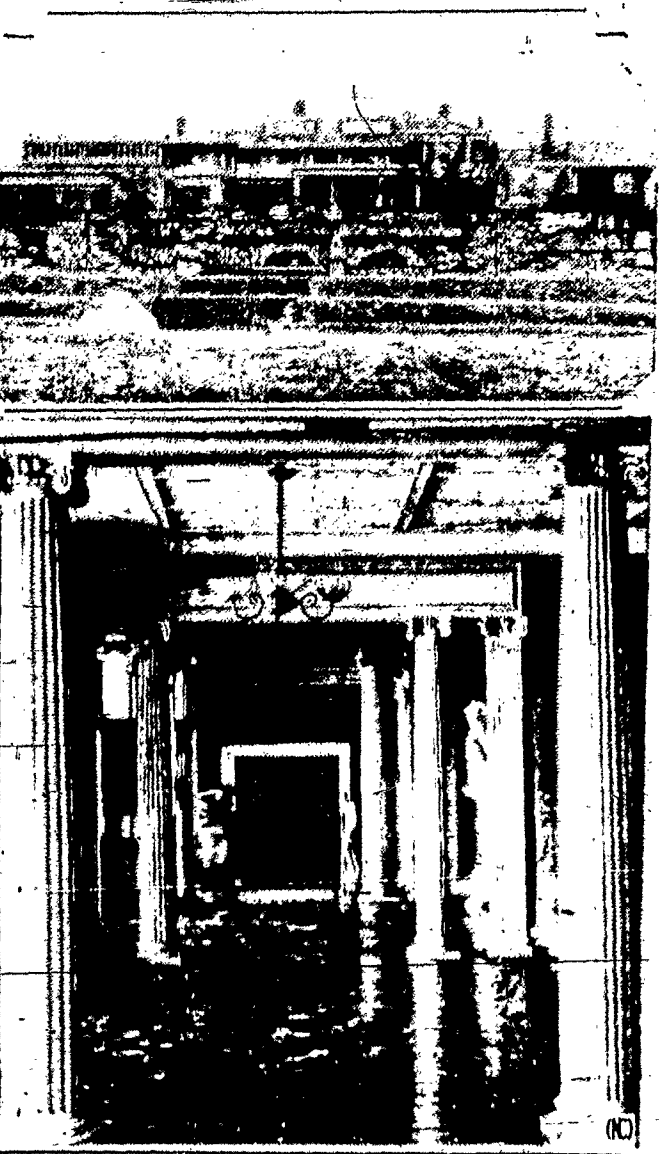
