## ITALIAN ARMY CHAPLAIN HAS HEROIC DEATH

Falls in Ethiopia Conflict; Visited Rochester Several Years Ago

Vatican City. An account of the heroic death of the Rev. Reginald Giuliani, O.P., killed in the Battle of Tembien at the Pass of Garibu in Abyssinia, has been communicated to the Dominican Fathers here by the Duke of Prasna and the Duke of Bergame, two Princes of the Royal House of Italy now at the fighting front in Africa.

His Heroism Praised. General Bellini, in announcing his death to the School of Artillery and Engineers where Father Giuliani was the Chaplain in Italy, said: "Father Reginald Giuliani is present in our hearts and minds through the work he has carried out among us for long years with such faith and such affection from the height of heaven he will always remain in our minds. The memory of Father Giuliani will always live perennially as a radiant figure of citizen, soldier and priest."

Letters to be Published. The letters that Father Giuliani wrote during this campaign are to be published in a book. ## ORIGINS OF EASTERN RITES, LITURGIES, CLERGY DESCRIBED IN CURRENT ARTICLE

Concordia, N. H. (NC) — Statistics and exhaustive information concerning that portion of the Catholic world which does not follow the Roman Rite are presented in the current number of Liturgical Arts, quarterly devoted to the art of the Catholic Church published here.

In an article entitled "The Eastern Branches of the Tree of Life," the Rev. Francis J. ## CONFRATERNITY WORK FRUITFUL, REPORTS TO HEADQUARTERS SHOW

Thousands in All Deaneries Join Enthusiastically In Organized, Simplified Study of Mass Ceremonies; 48 Clubs in Elmira Parish

A total of 740 discussion study clubs now engaged in the Lenten study of "The Ceremonies of the Mass," has been the diocesan-wide response to Archbishop Mooney's request for such organized lay activity sponsored by the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine.

This gratifying total is growing daily as reports reach the Rev. John M. Duffy, diocesan director of the Confraternity at his office in Columbus Civic Centre Building. Catholic laymen and laywomen under the guidance and energetic direction of priests in the various parishes are engaged in a program that is bringing about a greater appreciation of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and is developing informed laymen to speak authoritatively on their religion in outside circles.

Leaders in Movement. Began during the month of February the discussion study club movement was launched by series of deanery meetings held throughout the diocese. Demonstrations of the program were given by Father Duffy, the Rev. Charles J. Mahoney, assistant diocesan director and Miss Miriam Marks of Washington, national field secretary of the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine. These leaders in the movement were most enthusiastic this week as reports of formation of clubs and of work being done were coming into headquarters. Miss Marks who has aided in the establishment of discussion study clubs in dioceses throughout the United States and Canada declared that Rochester diocese's response was comparable to many other dioceses elsewhere and was superior to some.

Elmira Parish Leads. St. Patrick's parish, Elmira, of which the Rev. William J. Healy is pastor, has reported 48 active clubs now studying and discussing the Mass. The Rev. Daniel Holland is study club director and Major Claude Gravel is parish chairman. One study club promoter in the parish, Mrs. Catherine Maloney, president of the Sodality of Our Lady, organized 10 groups alone. These were made known groups in the third week of development. The Rev. Dr. William Byrnes, pastor of immaculate Conception Church gave a general demonstration of the methods of studying to all parishioners in the parish hall.
