The path marked out for the observance of the Easter rites in the Vatican, which is the most important of the city's religious activities, is a custom that goes back to the first centuries of the Church, and which had the most magnificent development during the Middle Ages. The Roman Missal has preserved an account of these rites, and the priests in celebrating them, are in thought in those churches of Rome where so many famous memories live again, and many famous relics are venerated.

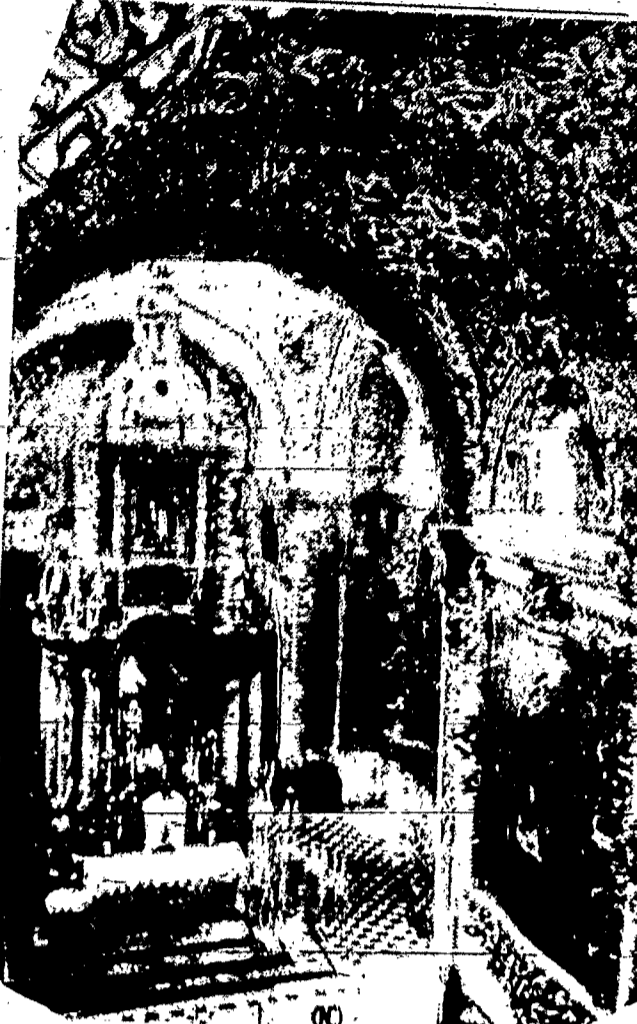

The tradition of the Stations in the Middle Ages was observed with such care that, if the Pope was sometimes prevented from taking part in them, a piece of cotton wool dipped in the oil of the lamp that burned in the church of the Station was brought to him, and the Pope kissed it, and then handed it to one of his courtiers that it might be put in the casket to be placed under his head on the day of his death. With the passing of centuries the tradition of the Stations was somewhat forgotten, and a sorrowful interruption was introduced into it when in the nineteenth century the Sec of the Holy See, Cardinal Antonini, transferred them to the Basilica of St. Peter.

### HOLY WEEK

Holy Week is inaugurated with the offering of blessed palm to the Pope. This palm is given by the descendants of the family of Esau of San Remo, to whom Pope Sixtus V gave the privilege to supply palms for the Sacred Apostolic See. The privilege came from the intervention of the sailor Brescia with his cry of "acqua alle funi" (Water on the ropes), while the great obelisk in the Square of St. Peter was being raised in the presence of the Pope Sixtus V.
