Current Rural Comment

COOPERATIVE CREDIT The impetus given to cooperation in rural parts of the United States during the past few years has not been limited to the fields of producers and consumers cooperatives. It has also extended to the field of credit.

Perhaps the most promising form of cooperative credit for the farmer is that known as the Credit Union. A Credit Union is a species of miniature cooperative bank. It receives deposits and makes loans. It is owned and managed by its members. Each member has but one vote in the election of officers.

To become a member of a Credit Union one must agree to save at least one share of five dollars, paying for it outright with cash or at the rate of twenty-five cents a week. If an individual can save fifty cents a week he subscribes to two shares; if one dollar a week, four shares; and so on. This, at any rate, is the usual procedure. Another requisite for membership in a Credit Union is a definite affiliation with the particular group in which the cooperative association is formed. For example, if it is organized on a parish basis, one must be a member of the parish in which it is formed. The individual asking the loan is the utmost importance. It would seem that particularly in the Parish Credit Union can loans be made wisely and safely, since parishioners are bound together with strong and enduring ties. They are not only neighbors and therefore know each other well, but are also of the same religious faith and of the same parochial family.

There is no question that the Credit Union movement is growing rapidly in our cities today. It is to be hoped that it will also soon show an appreciable growth in Catholic rural parishes.
