RULE NUNS CAN TEACH FOR STATE

High Tribunal Turns Down Appeal... Cite Qualifications... Board Tries to Enjoin Pay of Nuns

Bismarck, N. D.—(NC)—Catholic Sisters who meet the professional qualifications for the position may be employed as teachers in the common schools of North Dakota, even though they wear the garb of religious orders in the classroom and contribute part of their salary for the support of their motherhouse, the Supreme Court of North Dakota has ruled.

This decision is an earlier opinion in the state, County District Court.

The action started when Bishop von Hildebrand brought suit against the school board of the county to enjoin the board from paying salaries to four Sisters of St. Benedict who had been employed to teach in the consolidated school of Glendon.

BISHOP ASKS HITLER TO STOP CHURCH DRIVE

Most Rev. Van Galen Says Christ Must Be Preached by Nazis

Amsterdam—(NCW)—Directly addressing himself to Chancellor Adolf Hitler, the Most Rev. Clemens August Count von Galen, Bishop of Munster, Westphalia, issued an open challenge to the Nazi regime in his last Sunday sermon on the pulpit of the church of St. Erhard in Hannover, Gelsenkirchen.

Recalling that the late President von Hindenburg had expressed his successor the necessity that Christ be preached in Germany, but that this also being expressed by the German government and Hitler.

Maryknoll Founder Dies From Attack Of Pneumonia

Funeral Friday... Archbishop Mooney Will Pontificate At Requiem

The Catholic world today mourns the Most Rev. James Anthony Walsh, superior general of the Catholic Foreign Mission Society, who died Tuesday at the Maryknoll House, founded a quarter of a century ago.

The Most Rev. Archbishop Edward Mooney, Bishop of Rochester, will pontificate at a Solemn High Mass of Requiem for Bishop Walsh at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City Friday morning.

At present there are 185 Maryknoll priests and brothers overseas, and the Maryknoll sisters have sent out 209. The society's total enrollment is 650 and that of the Maryknoll sisters is 611.

Bishop Walsh's first title with the society was superior. In 1922, it was changed to superior general.

Born at Cambridge, Mass., he attended Boston College, Boston College from 1881 to 1885, Harvard from 1885 to 1894 and St. John's Ecclesiastical Seminary, Brighton, Mass., from 1894 to 1897.

He served from 1897 to 1902 as a curate at St. Patrick's Church, Roxbury, where, as spiritual director of associations of young people, he sponsored a study club known as the "Other Side of the Street."

In 1902 he was appointed director of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in Boston. As a curate he had little time for direct work for missions, but he did not forget his interest.

Realizing the need of mission literature, Bishop Walsh made several European trips to gather material for a number of books. The first of which was a biography of Blessed Theophane Venerand, a young member of the clergy was led by the Most Rev. Christian H. Winkelmann, Auxiliary Bishop of St. Louis, seated in pews in the front place, the remains of the St. Rev. Msgr. Timothy Dempsey were interred this week.

Church dignitaries, civic officials, labor leaders and his own poor joined in final tribute to "Father Tim," St. Louis' great apostle of charity.

The Most Rev. John J. Glennon, Archbishop of St. Louis, was the celebrant of the Pontifical Mass of Requiem at St. Patrick's Church. The sermon was preached by the Rt. Rev. Msgr. P. P. Crane, Vicar General. "You will find the sermon already preached," Monsignor Crane said. "The bandits have now retreated much farther into the mountains. This probably means that they will travel less."
